One advantage of a written lease, according to a booklet published by the Texas A&M University Off Campus Center, is that your rent cannot be raised during the length of time specified in the agreement unless it contains a re-ntal escalation clause.

In addition, Schulze said, repair and maintenance services available are usually outlined in written leases, and many times tenants will be required to refer to

their leases to know the correct procedure for requesting repairs. She said forms should always be filled out when moving into a unit indicating the condition of the apartment, so that residents are

not charged for damages they are not responsible for. Security deposits, or portions of them, are usually held if damage is done to the apartment during residency. Schulze said many students have broken leases in the past by moving out before their lease term had ended. She said this is a

breach of a legal agreement for which the apartment management may sue

Most major apartment com-plexes and housing areas are on or near the shuttle bus route. The buses run approximately every 20 minutes from 7 a.m.-10 p.m., Monday through Friday. Shuttle bus passes can be purchased from the Business Services office in 103 Rudder Tower. When you purchase a pass, you will also receive a free night and weekend parking permit from University Police. For those who bike or walk to

campus, the night and weekend parking permits may be purch-ased for \$5. For those who choose to drive to campus for classes, stickers are available for special day student parking lots. A car pool referral service is op-

erated by the Off Campus Center in the Puryear Hall Lounge across from the YMCA Building. Just stop by and fill out a card so that others interested in car pooling can contact you.
