OFFICIAL NOTICE TO STUDENT CONCERNING TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY STUDENT RECORDS POLICY

Annually, Texas A&M University informs students of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Ac 1974. This Act, with which the University intends to comply fully, is intended to protect the privacy education records, to establish the rights of students to inspect and review their education records, are provide guidelines for the correction of inaccurate or misleading data through informal and formal heart Students also have the right to file complaints with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act Office the Department of Education in Washington, D.C. concerning alleged failures by the University to on

Local policy explains in detail the procedures to be used by the University for compliance with provisions of the Act. Copies of the policy can be obtained at the Office of the Registrar, located in Hall on the Texas A&M University campus.

DIRECTORY INFORMATION

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 permits a university to establish of categories of information regarding students as "directory information," and to then disclose this into to third parties without the student's prior consent. However, prior to releasing directory information. concerning a student, the University must have afforded the student the opportunity to indicate it does not want directory information concerning himself released without his prior written permiss. Texas A&M University proposes to designate the following personally identifiable information on a student's education records as "directory information."

The student's name

The local address, home address including country, and the telephone numbers of the stuffer the date and place of birth of the student. The names and address of the student's parents

The student's major field of study

The student's class schedule
Participation in officially recognized activities and sports by the student
Weight and height of members of athletic teams

Dates of attendance, degrees and awards received

10. Previous educational agencies or institutions attended by the student

Sex, nationality, race and age of the student

The student's photograph

13. Achievement awards or honors14. The student's class standing

Parking permit information

The University will release "directory information" to third parties unless the University received written objection to such release in accordance with the procedure herein described.

Students who wish to have "directory information" withheld must complete the appropriate for Registrar's Office by Friday, September 18, 1981. Students who have requested information will

the past must renew their request each year within the first three weeks of the fall semester The student must realize that approximately one month is needed to remove this information materials already in circulation. However, the campus directory is printed only once a year, and

printing, no information can be removed.

The student is responsible for renewing this request each September, and the validity of the request each September 1 st.
