

inces and engineering.
The research will be conducted 18 federal research institutions with laboratories throughout the United States.

The programs provide scien-sts and engineers of unusual omise and ability with opportu-ties for research on problems argely of their own choosing yet npatible with the research inests of the supporting labora-

Initiated in 1954, the Assoateship Programs have contri-uted to the career development over 3,500 scientists ranging n recent Ph.D recipients to stinguished senior scientists.

About 250 new fulltime asso-

eships will be awarded on a petitive basis in 1982 for rearch in chemistry, engineering mathematics, and in the rth, environmental, physical,

the programs are open to both U.S. and non-U.S. nationals, and to both recent Ph.D holders and senior investigators

Awards are made for a year with possible extensions through a second year; senior applicants may request shorter tenures. Stipends range from \$22,400 a year for recent Ph.Ds to about \$50,000 a year for senior associ-

Allowances are made for relocation and for limited professional travel during tenure. The host federal laboratory provides the associate programmatic support including facilities, support services and necessary equipment.

Applications to the Research

Council must be postmarked no later than Jan. 15, 1982. Awards will be announced in April. Information on specific

search opportunities and federal laboratories, as well as application materials, may be obtained from the Associateship Office.
