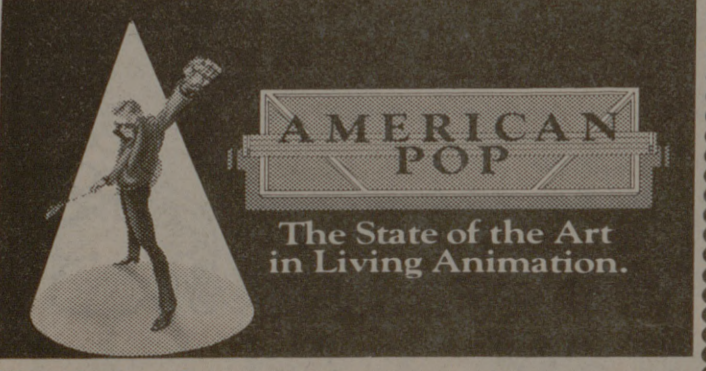

TCU hopes for miracle against powerful SMU

The rivalry between Southern Methodist and Texas Christian was once one of the hottest things going in the Southwest Conference, but for the past few decades it has been just another football game.

It will be more than just another game Saturday, however. SMU, which shows signs of being the best team in the SWC this season, will open its league campaign against a team it has beaten for the last nine years. Meanwhile, TCU has perhaps the most dangerous receiver in the country in Stanley Washington and the Horned Frogs are likely to start and finish the evening in the air.

"It ought to be quite a game," said Bud Elliott, the University of Texas at Arlington coach whose team has faced both the Mustangs and Frogs this season. "TCU has a chance to hang in there with them. I know one thing. You can't give TCU's receivers any room at all or it's all over."

The SMU-TCU matchup in Amon Carter Stadium will be one of two league games on the schedule this weekend.

Defending conference champion Baylor will begin defense of its crown at home against Texas Tech. Both teams have had problems in the early going although the Bears posted a 2-1 non-conference record and Tech is 1-1.

The rest of the league teams will be taking part in intersectional battles as the SWC tries to boost its 2-6 non-conference record.

Texas will host Miami in the top attraction while Rice visits LSU, Texas A&M entertains Louisiana Tech, Houston is at home against Utah State and Arkansas visits Mississippi.

Miami whipped Houston last weekend and will provide Texas with its stiffest test, while Houston will try to get things going with a new quarterback. Audrey McMillian has been lost for the season with a shoulder injury.

Holmes to put no title on line

PITTSBURGH — Larry Holmes will put his World Boxing Council heavyweight title on the line for the 11th time by fighting undefeated Renaldo Snipes Nov. 6 at Pittsburgh's 17,000-seat Civic Arena, officials said.

The fight, to be nationally televised in prime time — except in Pittsburgh — would be the first heavyweight title bout to be held in the city in 30 years and the first for Holmes, of Easton, Pa., in his native state.

The fight will be co-promoted by Don King and Civic Arena Corp., Edward DeBartolo's firm which owns the NHL Pittsburgh Penguins and the Pittsburgh Spirit of the Major Indoor Soccer League.

"We have a verbal agreement with Don King and we fully expect to do it (the fight)," Civic Arena spokesman Tom Rooney said Thursday. "One of our goals has been to bring pro boxing to Pittsburgh at a high level on a regular basis."

In the last heavyweight fight held in Pittsburgh, Joe Walcott knocked out Charles in 1951 at Forbes Field.

Rooney said a written agreement for the Holmes-Snipes fight would be drawn up and would be signed in the next week.

Rooney, who said he knows how much ticket revenue the fight would cost, said the fight would be televised in prime time on ABC, which has agreed to air it out in the Pittsburgh area.

"The fight had been scheduled for Cleveland but both cities were not available for Nov. 6," Rooney said. "Civic Arena Public Hall has a ski slope while Richfield Coliseum, which was scheduled Nov. 6,
