## National Haitian refugees face tougher entry barriers

WASHINGTON — Presidential orders aimed at stemming the flow of illegal Haitian immigrants authorize the Coast Guard to sail the high seas searching for Haitian boats, intercept them, inspect them, fire on them if necessary and turn them back.

Before the new orders came from President Reagan on Tuesday, the Coast Guard could only challenge vessels suspected of carrying illegal aliens after the boats entered U.S. territorial waters.

The new orders seem to protect refugees fleeing their homeland because of political persecution by authorizing the Coast Guard to ask for documents proving their status. But a State Department spokesman could not identify what type of document would prove a refugee was fleeing for political reasons.

Justice Department spokesman Thomas Stewart said: "We have discovered by talking to thousands of Haitians that they are very frank in saying they want to come to the United States to get a job. It's a very rare one who says he's coming because he wants to escape the government of Haiti."

Stewart said the new Coast Guard authority includes permission to fire weapons if a Haitian vessel does not respond to a call to halt for inspection.

But he said officers are unlikely to fire weapons. "This is a small boat against a cutter 400 feet long," Stewart said. "It could get their attention with a firehose."

The White House proclamation said: "The entry of undocumented aliens from the high seas is hereby suspended and shall be prevented by the interdiction of certain vessels carrying such aliens."

A spokeswoman for Sen. Paula Hawkins, R-Fla., said the measure "is aimed at the Haitians. The problem is with Haitians at the moment; Cubans aren't coming in."

The presidential proclamation stated the orders were released "in accordance with cooperative arrangements with certain foreign governments." White House and Justice Department officials have been negotiating for months with the Haitian government in an effort to curb the flow of illegal Haitian immigrants crowding into Florida.

Reagan's new executive order gives the Coast Guard the authority: "To stop and board defined vessels, when there is reason to believe that such vessels are engaged in the irregular transportation of persons or violations of United States law or the law of a country with which the United States has an arrangement authorizing such action."

"To make inquiries of those on board, examine documents and take such actions as are necessary to establish the registry, condition and destination of the vessel and the status of those on board vessel."

"To return the vessel and passengers to the country which it came, when there is reason to believe that an offense is being committed against the United States immigration laws, provided that no person who is a fugee will be returned without consent."

It stated the actions "are authorized to be undertaken only inside the territorial waters of United States."

Stewart said one Coast Guard cutter will be stationed near Haiti at all times. On board will be immigration officers and two interpreters who can speak Creole dialect predominant in Caribbean nation.

**Kansas City Hyatt hotel to re-open**

United Press International KANSAS CITY — Hyatt Hotel employees work round-the-clock putting finishing touches on the renovated hotel for today's reopening, more than two months after two massive skywalks fell and killed 10 people.

In what one Hyatt official called a formality, the Chamber of Commerce Citizen's Committee was submit a report on the Hyatt safety to Mayor Richard Berkley and the city council this morning.

The hotel unlocked its doors Wednesday for city leaders and building owners who said the were confidence the structure one of the safest in the country.

Berkley, members of the council, and officials from Hallmark Corp. and the Crown Center Redevelopment Corp. — owners of the Hyatt project — strolled through the lobby, focusing the attention primarily on the 10-foot wide terrace walkway that will connect the hotel's convention center with a 40-story guest tower.

The new walkway, called the West Terrace by Hyatt officials, takes the place of three steel-and-concrete aerial walkways that crashed to the lobby floor during a weekend revelers and injuring another 186.

The safety of the walkway is unquestionable, said Crown Center spokesman Jim Dawson.

"We feel sure that the hotel will be completely safe to open," Dawson said. "Public trust certainly is important to us and we would not be reopening our doors if we had the slightest doubts."

"So much care has gone into the remodeling, and the hotel has been so scrutinized, it's probably one of the safest in the country."

The new architectural features rests on 10 concrete pillars embedded in the hotel's concrete foundation two stories below.

The daughter of a victim of the disaster said she will picket outside the hotel while city officials inside attend a dinner Friday to celebrate the hotel's reopening.

Jill Tvedten-Long, 21, daughter of Kansas City firefighter John Tvedten Sr., said she is staging the protest to express her dissatisfaction with the way the city handled the disaster — particularly the way the city's building codes are enforced and the manner in which the third skywalk was removed unannounced in the dead of night.
