# Billy Beer — big supply, but nobody's demanding

A lot of people are hoping to get rich on Billy Beer, the brew named for the Georgia filling station operator who was once the nation's premier "good ol' boy." The asking price is as much as \$1,000 a can, but a UPI survey shows you better not plan on paying for your old age with that six-pack stuck away in the garage. Nobody's buying.  
In fact, collectors say Billy Beer is really worth 75 cents, which isn't much more than what it sold for when it was marketed during Billy Carter's heyday as the president's brother in 1977 and 1978. Although no one really seemed to like the taste of his namesake beer, some people, did stock up on Billy Beer, hoping it would be-

come a nostalgia item.  
Cecil "Chick" Burr of Birmingham, Ala., said Billy Beer was the "awfullest tasting beer I've tasted," but bought a few cases from Carter's Plains, Ga., gasoline station for \$7.50 each. He says the beers are worth \$1,000 a can.  
"The biggest offer I got was \$250 a can, but I'm not going to give it away," he said. "I'll just hang onto it because I'm not selling under the going price."  
Classified ads have appeared in newspapers around the nation with most collectors seeking about \$500 for an unopened can. However, it seems to be a market based on supply and no demand.  
Amri Chumbley of Louisville, Ky., paid \$325 for three cases several weeks ago but the best offer

he has had so far is \$120 for one. "I'm surprised it is so low," he said. "I think within a year you won't be able to buy them for less than \$2,000, \$3,000 a can."  
Pearl marketing director Kratz said his brewery has received more than 1,000 calls in letters in the past six months. "Please don't call us," he said. "There were rumors we were buying the cans back but that's not earthy reason for us to buy them. People are really getting suckered into this."  
"To us, it's worth 25 cents a pound for the metal cans. These are about 23 cans in a pound. If you want to bring in your own cans, we'll give you two cents per case."

# No beard, no pigtails on Willie Nelson while he recovers from collapsed lung

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — Say it isn't so — a clean-shaven, short-haired Willie Nelson?  
The country singer with a reputation as a rebel snipped his long, red pigtails and shaved his bushy beard. His agent, Mark Rothbaum, predicts Nelson, who is recovering from the mend from a collapsed lung, will not remain unshy for long.  
"It's no big thing," Rothbaum said. "The last time he did it was a

couple of years ago."  
The news surfaced shortly after Nelson paid a quiet visit to Nashville Sept. 11 and stayed about a week, said CBS Records press director Woody Bowles.  
Bowles said Nelson may be in Texas or Colorado — "He has homes in both places" he said. The injury forced cancellations of his remaining August and September concerts.  
Nelson, 48, is recovering from a collapsed lung which left him hos-

pitalized in Hawaii in mid-August. He is the author of such country classics as "Crazy," "Blue Eyes Crying in the Rain" and "Whispering Willies." "For Willie is basically having a complete recovery. He's been moving about on a very limited basis, and any travel he's doing is strictly for rest and relaxation."
