

# S.C. boy going to Sadat burial

United Press International LIBERTY, S.C. — Ninth grad-er Sam Brown, dressed in his new gray three-piece suit, will stand alongside three former U.S. presidents and other world leaders at

Saturday's funeral for slain Egyptian President Anwar Sadat.

The White House granted permission Wednesday for the 14-year-old, who traveled to Egypt in 1979 as a guest of Sadat to fix to 1979 as a guest of Sadat, to fly to Egypt aboard Air Force One as part of the official U.S. delegation.

Sam was scheduled to fly to Washington today and travel to


The teenager said his interest in military history and the Middle East prompted him to write Sadat in 1979, praising his peace-making efforts.
