## TDC clinic inadequate, experts say

HOUSTON — A Texas Department of Health survey found inadequate space, disorganization and unqualified staffing at a Texas Department of Corrections main hospital last summer.

TDC's own evaluation had a national standard accreditation for the hospital unit was "unimpressive," but TDC officials have pleaded that the 120-bed facility — the lead facility in a prison system of clinics — not be closed.

They say a new hospital under construction at the University of Texas Center in Galveston will solve prison medical shortcomings.

The state experts, who filed their report in August, found — The hospital did not employ enough professional staff. The organization of staff and the administration of drugs were not met.

—The hospital laboratory had substandard quality control and used inmates as technicians. An expert said five of 11 inmates working in the lab could not meet state standards as lab technicians.

—The hospital did not keep adequate medical records and inmate workers had access to the records.

—The hospital did not provide enough storage for surgical and other equipment.

—There was not enough space for routine hospital needs such as handwashing.

The report is the second indictment of the hospital filed in a federal court case in which U.S. District Judge William Wayne Justice of Tyler, has ordered major reforms.

Dr. Robert Cohen, a New York prison physician hired as Justice's special master for reform.

TDC Director Jim Estelle rejected suggestions the Huntsville Unit hospital be closed and said TDC is moving as rapidly as it can to improve medical care with added staff and the new \$48 million hospital under construction in Galveston.

## Arkansas is flooded with people

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. — There's no room at the inn — or almost anywhere else — in northwest Arkansas this weekend, but area residents are opening their homes to house visitors for the Arkansas-Texas football game and two arts and crafts fairs.

Rogers Chamber of Commerce President Gene Ramsey last week asked area residents to contact his office if they had spare rooms and would be willing to house visitors. The chambers of commerce in Fayetteville, Springdale and Bentonville have received calls, too, and are trying to drum up hosts for the guests.

"We knew of about six motel rooms in the whole city early Monday, and I'm sure they're full now," Pam Lakey, information secretary of the Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce said Wednesday. "I've never seen this kind of situation."

"We're always full for the Razorbacks' home football games, but never like this. Usually, the people can stay all over northwest Arkansas."

The Arkansas-Texas game always attracts a crowd of about 40,000, and room will have to be found this time for ABC's television crew and a host of sportswriters.

The Texas team is staying 50 miles away at Fort Smith, and some of the Texas sportswriters will be 100 miles away in Tulsa, officials said. Another 100,000 people are expected at the War Eagle Arts and Crafts Show near Rogers, and a smaller crafts fair is scheduled at Bella Vista.

The crowding is complicated by Columbia Pictures' filming of the Civil War miniseries, "The Blue and the Gray," in northwest Arkansas.

"We're trying hard to be good neighbors," Columbia producer Harry Thomason said. "Our guys have already become Razorback fans."

The new Hilton in Fayetteville will have its 244 rooms full for the first time.

"We're getting baptized to football weekends on the worst possible one," manager Dale Athey said. "The number of requests for rooms is staggering."
