A&M at Galveston celebrates 10th year

Texas' first separate-campus venture into marine sciences education will be recognized Friday through Sunday in observances marking the 10th anniversary of Texas A&M at Galveston.
Classes in marine engineering and transportation, marine science and marine biology were consolidated on the acre Pelican Island campus in 1971 as an outgrowth of oceanography research. The research began at Texas A&M in College Station in the early 1950s. Dr. William Clayton, president of the Galveston campus said.
The institution enrolls 600 students studying marine-related topics and more than 200 cadets earning a license to serve as officers in the U.S. Merchant Marine.
The University operates a 15,000-foot converted ocean liner, the Texas Clipper, which serves as the training ship for merchant marine cadets. The campus also serves as the home port for one of the largest research fleets in the nation, including one of the newest oceanographic research vessels built for the Navy, a submarine and several small craft used for pollution studies in the Houston Ship Channel and along the Texas coast.
