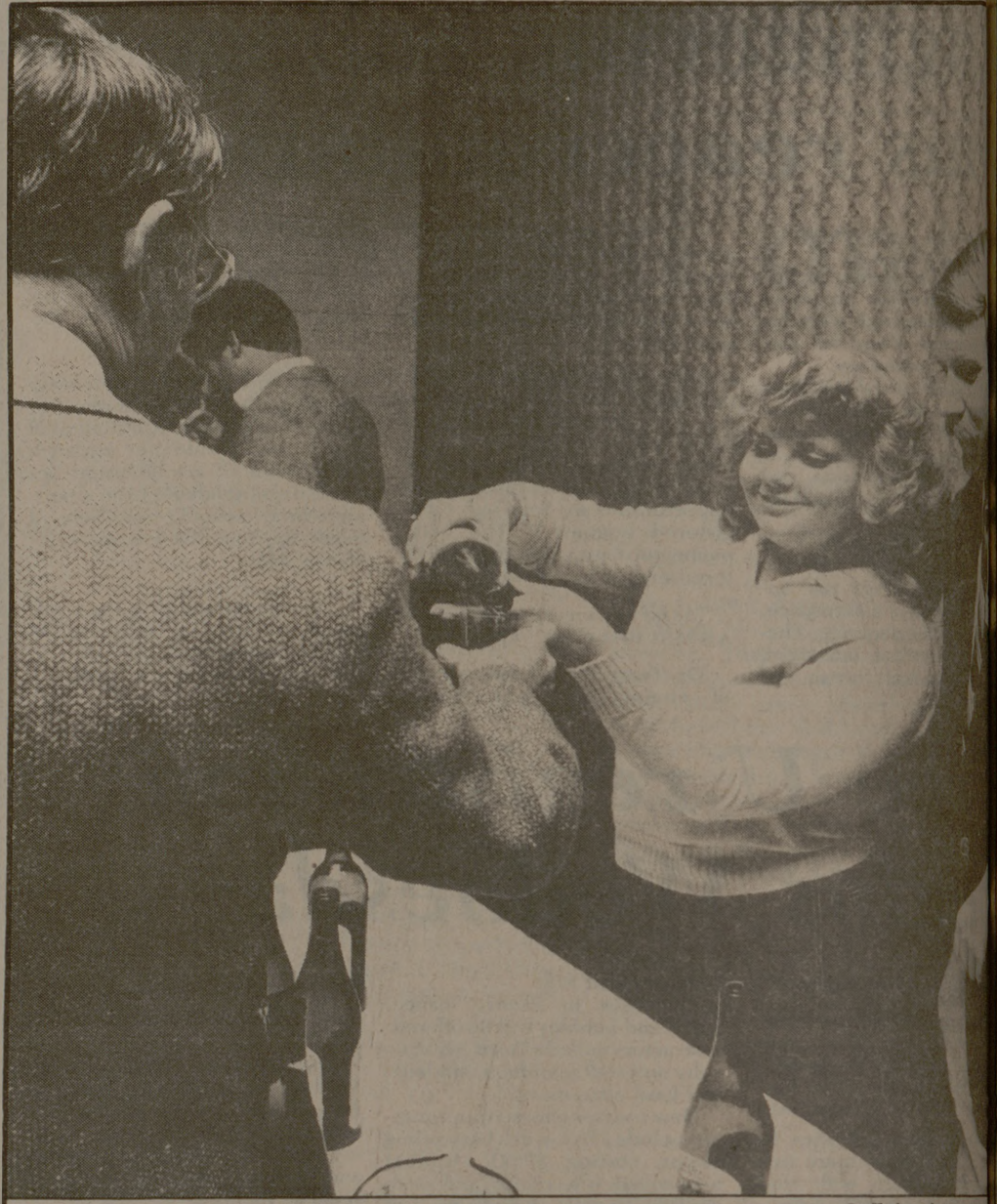
Although there won't be a costume contest at this year's party, the children should wear Hallo-

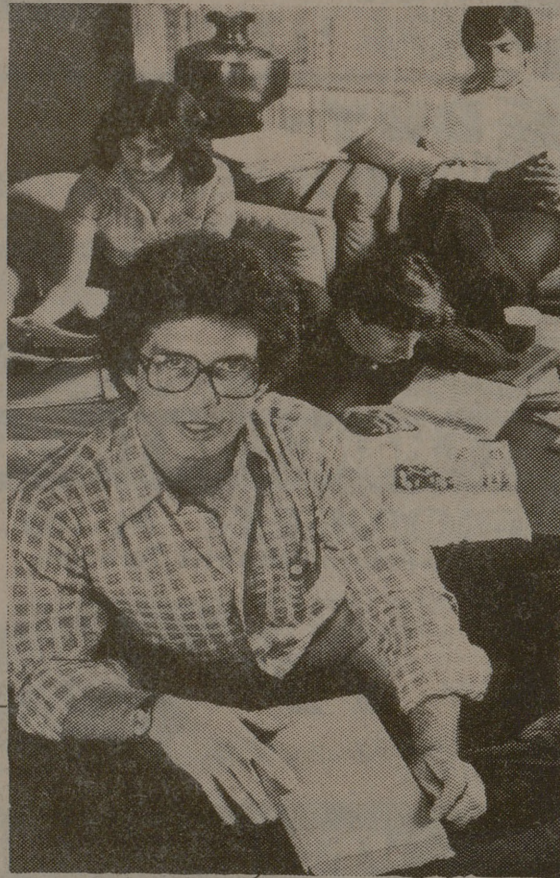

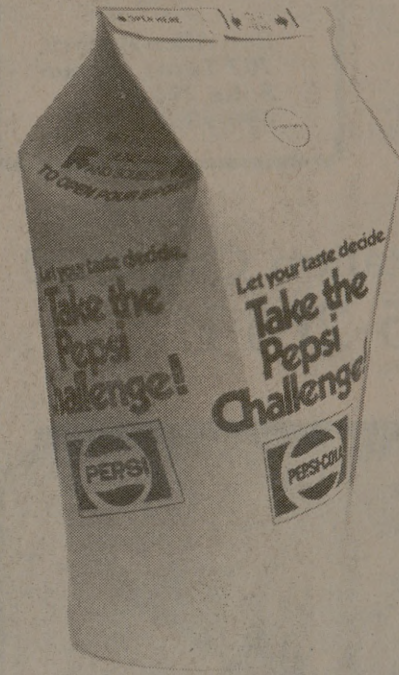
