

## U.S. ambassadors issued bulletproof cars, vests

WASHINGTON — Several U.S. ambassadors were recently given bulletproof cars and bulletproof vests because of possible trouble from Libyan-supported terrorist groups, administration sources say.  
The sources also disclosed Sunday that the U.S. ambassador to Italy, Maxwell M. Rabb, was recalled to Washington two weeks ago partly because of a threat by terrorists to kidnap and assassinate him.  
Administration officials, who asked not to be identified, said security precautions at U.S. embassies, consulates and American military bases abroad have been markedly increased because of the possibility Libyan Col.

Moammar Khadafy may seek revenge for the downing last summer of two Libyan jets by U.S. fighters.  
Many top officials now ride in bulletproof cars and a number wear bulletproof vests, sources said. They would not identify the ambassadors given extra security.  
Rabb, 71, appointed ambassador by President Reagan, was recalled from Italy at least two weeks ago, in part because of a threat of kidnapping, the sources said.  
The New York Times reported authorities had uncovered a Libyan plot to assassinate Rabb and he was hastily recalled to Washington.  
Official sources said it was a kidnapping threat "with appropriate publicity leading to an assassination," but they refused to identify the source of the threat and would

not comment on a possible Libyan connection.  
And sources stressed the recall could have been handled in three ways by Italian and U.S. intelligence authorities, and the prime reason Rabb — an influential Jewish liberal Republican — was recalled was to help lobby senators on behalf of the AWACS plane sale to Saudi Arabia.  
In Rome, a U.S. Embassy official called the New York Times report nonsense.  
Rabb will return to Italy after the Senate votes on the AWACS sale this Wednesday, an administration source said.  
Rabb could not be reached for comment.  
A State Department spokesman Joseph Reap said, "Ambassador Rabb was recalled for a number of reasons, one of which was for formal consultations." Reap refused to disclose the other reasons.  
But a department official who asked not to be identified confirmed that one reason was a possible threat to his security.  
In its Oct. 19 edition, Newsweek magazine reported Khadafy had sent a hit team to Italy to assassinate Rabb in retaliation for the United States shooting down two Libyan jets over the Gulf of Sidra last August.  
The Newsweek report was the subject of extensive attention in the Italian press.
