State Galveston Island area glows again

United Press International GALVESTON — A Galveston County constable who didn't believe reports of weird lights in the sky has changed his tune. "I never did believe in unidentified flying objects until Wednesday night," Constable Joe Serofoe said.

Wednesday was the third consecutive night the lights from a unidentified source appeared over Galveston County, but it was first time the lights were reported in inland towns.

Serofoe said he watched from Hitchcock, about 10 miles west of Galveston Island.

"All I could see was a big bright light," he said. "It seemed like it might have a red light on the end of it. I thought it could have been a rocket but figured it wasn't because it wasn't moving."

Police dispatchers in Hitchcock and Texas City, also about 10 miles inland, said several residents reported the weird glow overhead.

The Coast Guard said the glow was probably caused by reflections from burn-off fires on offshore oil rigs, but Serofoe rejected that opinion.

"There's something up there," he said. "I don't know what it is, but it's up there."

Woman's car explodes; dealer changes his tune

United Press International PLANO — Elizabeth Thompson said she was sweet-talked when she purchased a new Dodge, but was treated quite differently after the car exploded in her driveway last weekend.

"Of course they were lovely when they tried to sell me the car," Thompson said. After the car

exploded a month later, she went to talk to the dealership's general manager.

"The first thing he said to me was, 'I understand you have a problem, little girl. I am 41. I am a very well-educated, mature woman. It got worse from there. There's no talking to them.'"

At one point, she said, she was told to take what insurance money she could get and be quiet about the whole thing.

"That's what insurance companies are for," she said her dealer told her.

But Thompson wants a new car. And she said she won't give up until she gets satisfaction.

Thompson said she parked her brand new Dodge Aries K-car in her driveway Friday night and at about 1:30 a.m. Saturday, it blew up.

Spokesmen for the Federal Trade Commission and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration told a Dallas newspaper they have not received any complaints about similar problems with the Dodge K-cars.

But Thompson contradicted the statement in the newspaper, saying neither agency has yet dis-

covered if other incidents occurred because it takes at least four days for reports to be processed.

"I had three calls today work," she said. "Evidently other people have had problems with their cars, too."

Neither the dealership nor which she bought the car nor insurance company is eager to comply in full.

Thompson said her insurance company, State Farm, would give her the blue book value of the car, which would classify it as a 30-day-old car at a 1-year-old value.

"Most people just go ahead and collect their insurance," Thompson said Wednesday. "They are not willing to go to court and just take the pittance the insurance companies offer. I'm not willing to do that."

"My insurance company would be easier for me to take insurance money even though I can't buy a car with it and they would sue Chrysler."

The dealership that Thompson the car offered to sell her a 1982 Aries for \$1,000.
