Honor society broadening role

Although Lambda Sigma is an honor society, recognizing scholastic achievements is not its only function.
The national sophomore organization also attempts to promote traditions and activities and encourage fellowship through service to the campus community.

"We're really less of an honor society and more of a strong fellowship and service project group," Sue Lednicki, Lambda Sigma vice president, said.
One way Lambda Sigma members do this is by meeting several times each week with a faculty member to exchange ideas and information about their services.
In addition to the weekly meet-

ings, Lambda Sigma members meet with professors and deans to discuss current University issues. The members take feedback from the faculty and fill out forms, which are given to the University's Academic Council. Lambda Sigma, along with the Junior Honor Society, were asked by the Academic Affairs Committee of Student Government to take part in this project.

Distribution of signs publicizing activities for student organizations is another of the group's projects. Poster routes include 160 "University news only" bulletin boards in 28 dorm and academic areas, excluding Sterling C Evans Library and the Memorial Student Center.

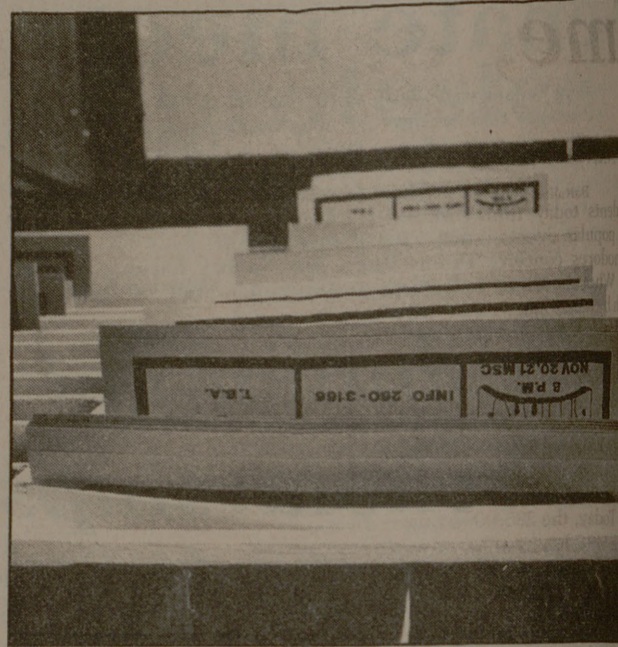
Any recognized student organization can use this service by submitting at least 160 copies of posters to Lambda Sigma at the Student Programs Office, 216 MSC. The weekly deadline to get posters distributed is noon Monday.

Lambda Sigma members are chosen at the end of their freshman year depending on high school record, involvement in extracurricular activities, personal character and leadership and service abilities.

Requirements also include a 3.25 grade point ratio, plus a 15-hour course load for the first semester. Filing deadline is in March.

Last year 50 students were chosen for membership from more than 400 applicants.

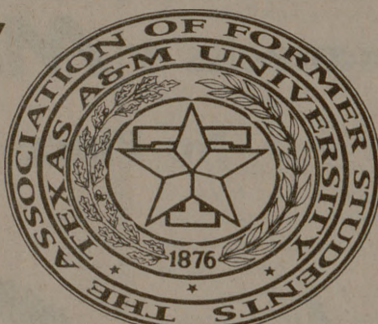
recruit outstanding high school students by hosting student visitors at their homes and providing complete tours of the campus.

State attorney general accuses Klan of paramilitary training

HOUSTON — A deposition filed in federal court says the paramilitary arm of the Ku Klux Klan

has met twice a month for the past six years at various locations in the state.

The statement by Robert John

Sisente, identified as leader of Klan's Texas Emergency Reserve, was attached to written arguments in which Texas Attorney General Mark White seeks a court order stopping the Klan activities in Texas.

However, another statement from former Grand Dragon L. Beam said the group had stopped meeting last March.

The attorney general's assessment: "One fact remains clear. It is a functioning military organization capable of violent action."

U.S. District Judge Gabriel McDonald, who is considering White's petition for a shutdown order, requested the written arguments from the state and law for the Klan and said she would rule later this year. White filed a shutdown petition as an intervenor in a lawsuit by Vietnamese fishermen against the Klan. Judge last May ordered the Klan stop harassing Vietnamese fishermen in the Kemah-Seabrook area.

The sites identified as training areas were Lyndon Johnson National Grassland, Wise County northwest of Worth, near Winnie between Houston and Beaumont, County Bravo near Liberty, and "Alpha Base," location not given.
