Teenager charged with nun's death

AMARILLO — The bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Amarillo said he hoped the teenager charged with capital murder in the rape and beating death of an elderly nun would express "God's love and forgiveness" if he is guilty.
Police Tuesday charged 17-year-old Frank Garrett, with murder during the commission of a felony — a capital offense — youth is accused of the Oct. 16 attack on Sister Tadea Biera, who was raped, beaten and strangled in her convent room.
"We felt a great sense of sorrow that a suspect was arrested," Bishop L.P. Matheisen said Tuesday. "The sisters of Saint Francis, even with the 24-hour-a-day surveillance were ill at ease."
Matheisen, bishop of Amarillo diocese, said he hopes the "young man" in question is guilty, "he will be given the tending and remedial care to experience God's love and forgiveness."
Police said Garrett, who was arrested at his home without a warrant late Monday on a charge of capital murder, lives in a few blocks from the Saint Francis Convent.
In a Tuesday hearing before Garrett's mother, Justice the Peace L.P. Bartlett denied bond on the capital murder charge and set a \$5,000 bond for the unauthorized use of a vehicle charge.
The youth was picked up by police for prowling the same night Sister Tadea was slain and name was placed on a suspect list that led to the Monday arrest, was identified by fingerprints found on a knife in the room.
The fingerprints were obtained using a new argon laser system installed at the Potter County Sheriff's Department several days after the nun's death. The fingerprint device detected a print on the wood-handled knife.
Potter County District Attorney Danny Hill said, "evidence started falling into place" when investigator remembered youth had been picked up for prowling.
"The investigator recalled particular person and suggested that he be checked out," said Hill.
"We feel there's no doubt got our man," said Amarillo Police Chief Jerry Neill.
Garrett's arrest appeared cleared a 28-year-old Cuban fugitive identified as a suspect in the case last week. Tests on clothing and fabric samples taken from the body of the slain nun were inconclusive after an analysis by the FBI's Washington D.C. crime lab.
Police said earlier this week the fugitive was "temporarily" considered as a prime suspect in the case because of burglary and attempted rape charges stemming from an attack on a young woman.
The fugitive remained jailed on those charges.
