Moore, speaking to the Class of 81 Senior Induction Banquet in the Ramada Inn, said the Associa-tion of Former Students is dedicated to improving Texas A&M in three areas: students, faculty and

"We believe we should fill in to help Texas A&M in areas where other people haven't," he said.

Moore, a former state representative and a member of the Class of '52, said the association has helped improve the quality of the student body at the University since the early 1960s when it

began actively recruiting students from high schools.

The association continues to meet with high school and junior college counselors annually to inform them of University pro-



every year.


