As kickoff between the Arkansas Razorbacks and Texas Aggies nears more and more talk centers around the winner having a clear shot at the Cotton Bowl.

That's not entirely true, however. The 1981 Southwest Conference race is one full of surprises. Just ask Arkansas' Lou Holtz. The Razorbacks traveled to Fort Worth earlier this year to play TCU and returned to Fayetteville with a 28-24 loss. Then, just one week later humiliated the Texas Longhorns 42-11 on tv.

The point is anything can happen. Anybody can beat anybody on a given day.

Despite what may happen Saturday the season is not over for either team. While the winner does have a good shot at the Cotton Bowl, the loser has a good chance at another bowl. That, of course, hinges on the assumption that both teams play well the remainder of the season, or at least until Nov. 21 when bowl bids will be handed out.
