





merce Department will lodge charges against an exporter who allegedly tried to ship 5,000 pounds of the metal zirconium, used as shielding in nuclear reactors, to Pakistan.

Pakistan is believed to be de-

veloping nuclear weapons. The shipment, packed in 15 crates and marked as mountainclimbing equipment, was seized Oct. 31 at Kennedy Airport as it was about to be loaded aboard a Pakistan Airlines jet bound for Islamabad.

The Commerce Department identified the shipper as National-Tronics Corp. of New York City and the intended recipient as Dr.


