Virtually every assassination expert agrees that three shots could have been fired from the Texas School Book Depository overlooking Kennedy's motorcade route, but four shots would have been impossible. If the 12-member National Academy of Sciences team concludes four shots were fired the American public would be presented with more persuasive evidence of a second gunman.

Barbara Jorgenson, a spokes-woman for the NAS in Washing-ton, D.C., said the committee's report has been completed and is undergoing internal review. She said the NAS hoped to release it by the end of the year.

The report was originally due in January but, she said, "it was a very touchy subject, and the committee wanted to make absolutely sure that its analysis was right. The draft report was approved last week, but Jorgenson would not say how many shots the panel concluded were fired.
