## Defense request expected to receive Senate approval

**WASHINGTON** — President Reagan's most controversial weapons requests — the MX missile and B-1 bomber — face their final congressional hurdle this week when the Senate acts on the most expensive weapons program in U.S. history.

The systems, with a combined cost of \$4.4 billion, are expected to survive efforts to trim the \$208.5 billion defense appropriations bill. The Senate version is \$7.6 billion more than Reagan asked, and \$11.9 billion higher than the House version which was approved Nov. 19.

"The committee supports the need for increased defense spending to meet the threats to U.S. national security interests in the 1980's," said the Senate Appropriations Committee report.

"The major increase in Soviet defense spending throughout the 1970's as well as Soviet adventurism in Africa, Asia and Latin America pose a serious threat to U.S. security interests throughout the world," the report said.

The Senate bill proposes spending \$2.4 billion for the B-1 bomber and \$2 billion for the MX missile.

It also includes nearly \$600 million for weapons procurement, \$20.8 billion for research and development, and more than \$100 million for other programs, including civil defense.

The bill also appropriates money for warplanes, a new aircraft carrier, nuclear attack submarines, cruisers and guided missile frigates, Army helicopters and more than 1,300 combat vehicles.
