wouldn't take it. We wouldn't take his offer, and he wouldn't take ours."

As for the next step, Bright said it was "just to continue what we've been doing" — in other words, talking to other pros-

pects about the athletic director/football coach job. Bright said several other prospects are still being considered.

Vandiver didn't release a statement after Schembechler's decision, but said Sunday from his home that a search committee chooses candidates for the athletic directorship. He said the committee is made up of himself, Samson and regents John Blocker Sr., William McKenzie and Royce Wisenbaker.

However, at this point in the search for an athletic director, Vandiver's role apparently has been a limited one. And by his own admittance, the University president has no idea what will happen next.

"If I knew, I'd tell you," he said. "If you find out, please let me know."

Vandiver said the authority to hire and fire an athletic director lies with the administration.

"The authority as you define it by the books is in the board of regents and the president of the University," he said.

As for whether the University's athletic director has the power to assume the duties of head football coach, Vandiver said: "Normally, he has control over all the coaches. If he decides that any are incompetent, he can dismiss them. He recommends to the administration what can happen within the Athletic Department."

Texas A&M football coaches, in the midst of the disturbing incidents occurring within the Athletic Department, greeted their first group of high school football recruits over the weekend. However, the coaches and hosting members of the Aggie football team did their best to make their guests forget about the disorder.

Texas A&M Recruiting Coordinator Dan LaGrasta said that the 24 prospects, the first of four groups which will visit the University during the next few weeks, includes several outstanding prospects.

"The start of our recruiting is better now than it has been in a long time," LaGrasta said. "We've been able to get some of

the top prospects in the state to visit A&M."

— Jimmy Hawkins, 5-11, 195-pound running back from San Antonio Holmes;

— Chris Lammers, 6-5, 225-pound defensive tackle from San Antonio Churchhill;

— Troy Taylor, 6-1, 170-pound quarterback from Allen;

LaGrasta and Assistant Coach Gary DeLoach said Lee, a blue-chip prospect who has narrowed his choice down to Texas A&M, USC and Oklahoma, may be the top lineman in the state.
