Aggies to live in converted monastery

Summer study in Italy offered

If you've ever wanted to see Italy Aggie-style, now's your chance. The College of Liberal Arts and the College of Architecture and Environmental Design will co-sponsor a study program in Italy for Texas A&M students May 17 through June 18.

An international meeting for students interested in the program will be held at 5 p.m. Wednesday in 302 Rudder. The five-week program, to be taught by Texas A&M faculty members, will allow students to earn up to six hours of credit in a variety of humanities and fine arts courses, said Daniel F. MacGilvray, assistant dean of the

College of Architecture and Environmental Design. MacGilvray, coordinator of the program, said students will live and study in La Poggerina Monastery, in Figline, Italy. The monastery — actually a remodeled study center with dormitories — is about 19 miles from Florence and has a housing capacity of 100 students. Any Texas A&M student is eligible to attend the summer study, MacGilvray said. The program will cost \$2,000 and will include round-trip air fare from Houston, room and board at the monastery, in-state tuition and fees and field trips to surrounding areas.

MacGilvray said Wednesday's meeting will include a slide show of Florence and the monastery, a discussion of costs and information about available financial aid. Students also will meet the four program instructors who will discuss the courses to be taught this summer. The instructors for the summer will be Joe Hutchinson, professor of environmental design; Julie Lepick, assistant professor of English; Hugh McCann, associate professor of philosophy; and Tony Stranges, assistant professor of history. The courses to be taught are:

Art 350, The Arts and Civilization; Art 485, Special Topics in Drawing and Painting; Art 489, The Renaissance in England; English Independent Study; History of Science; Philosophy 305, Philosophy of Science; Philosophy 330, Philosophy of Art. MacGilvray said interested students who are unable to attend the meeting Wednesday should call him at his office, 845-1222. Deposits for the summer study will be taken February, he said.

Crime Stoppers looks for stolen rig supplies

Oil fields in Brazos County are not immune to a growing oil field theft problem, and this week, Crime Stoppers wants to know who stole oil field equipment worth more than \$5,400 from a drilling rig just off the East By-pass.

Sometime between Dec. 24 and Jan. 5, an Exxon drilling rig on Old Reliance Road was burglarized and the following items stolen:

- Two B.J. Elevators (2 3/8), Model T-100, each of which is stenciled "TBS 73" and coated with rust-colored primer;
- Safety clamps, Bash Ross Type "T"; and
- One B.J. Elevator (3 1/2),

Model T-100, with the word "Trico" and the number 253 welded on.

The 2 3/8 elevators are worth \$1,600 each and the 3 1/2 elevator is valued at \$2,200.

Crime Stoppers is paying \$1,000 for information it receives this week, which leads to the arrest and indictment of a person or persons responsible for this crime. Citizens with any information about the person or who know of any of the equipment being bought or under suspicious circumstances should call Crime Stoppers 775-TIPS. Callers need not reveal their names, and Crime Stoppers guarantees anonymity.

Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$1,000 for information leading to an arrest and conviction in any unsolved felony case, also, callers' names will be kept secret. This week's Crime Stoppers Week will be re-enacted on Channel 3, KBTX-TV, 6 p.m. and 10 p.m. news.
