

United Press International WASHINGTON — A gas company lobbyist was fired for writing to Interior Secretary James Watt, disagreeing with a remark he made at a political fund-raiser, it was reported

Tuesday.

The Washington Post reported that Timothy L. Donohoe, 36, a Washington representative for the Dallas Enserch natural gas company, was dis-missed earlier this month for writing Watt about his com-

Donohoe said he had written Watt about a speech the secretary made in California. Watt was quoted as saying in the speech: "I never use the words Republicans and Democrats. It's liberals and Americans.'

Donohoe wrote Watt on private stationery bearing his office address and asked for an explanation. Donohoe wrote that he considered himself both a liberal and an American.

Donohoe said his boss called him in two weeks later and

showed him a copy of his letter to Watt and a reply written by Stanley Hulett, director of the Interior Department's congressional affairs office.

Hulett wrote that Watt's remark was part of a joke told at a political fund-raiser and not meant seriously.

Donohoe said he was then fired for "lack of judgment" in writing his letter.






