Good eyewear fits rests on the nose

HOUSTON — If you cannot read while looking down because your eyeglasses always slide to the tip of your nose, the problem is not with your nose. The problem is that frames are designed for a range of nose bridges and not to your specific measurements. One researcher is hoping to change that approach to eyewear.

"Far too many eyeglass patients are wearing frames that do not fit," says Freeda Storm, an instructor at the University of

Houston College of Optometry. Storm's area of expertise is the proper fit and appearance of eyeglasses frames. She is conducting a major study of the nose bridge help the optical community rectify fit frames.

A pair of eyeglasses is effective when a patient is through the optical center lenses. If the frames do not slip down the nose, the patient is not receiving the corrective power of the lens.

Man pleads guilty to killing girl, 10

VICTORIA — Jerry Lane Jurek, whose case the Supreme Court used to uphold the death penalty in 1976, pleaded guilty Wednesday to capital murder in the 1973 strangulation-drowning of a 10-year-old Cuero girl.

Jurek, whose earlier conviction in the death of Wendy Adams was overturned by the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals, pleaded guilty in return for a life sentence in the state penitentiary.

Jurek testified Wednesday that he took the girl, a police-

man's daughter, from the municipal swimming pool without her consent. The plea gain agreement also had satisfied Jurek admitted to attempting to have sexual intercourse with the girl before the killing but he did not admit to the stand. The plea agreement still has to be accepted by the eight-man woman jury.

Testimony in the case had been moved from Cuero Victoria on a change of venue started Monday in the courtroom of State District Judge Clarence Stevenson.

Cop letter releases Tyler man

ODESSA — A Tyler businessman who served 17 months in prison for an assault he admitted he committed has produced a letter written by ex-Tyler police officer A. D. Ethridge as evidence of a conspiracy in the Tyler Police Department.

Kenneth Bora said Tuesday he would drop a \$15 million suit against the East Texas corrupt city officials and posed.

In his suit, Bora claimed Tyler police Chief William Hardy, Smith County District Attorney Hunter Brush, Assistant District Attorney Harrison, undercover agent Creig Matthews and Kim Ramsey lied and suppressed evidence to gain the assault conviction. Matthews and Ramsey have been married.

"While in the vice division I saw the things that Creig Matthews and Kim Ramsey were doing that were wrong," Bora said. "I also saw Willie Hardy approve of the wrongdoings, saying things such as 'Well ahead and do it this way and we get caught we'll do the most honorable thing to do and that is to lie.'"

Bora, acquitted three times of cocaine charges, was charged with firing a shotgun through a window of the Matthews mobile home on Sept. 15, wounding both officers.

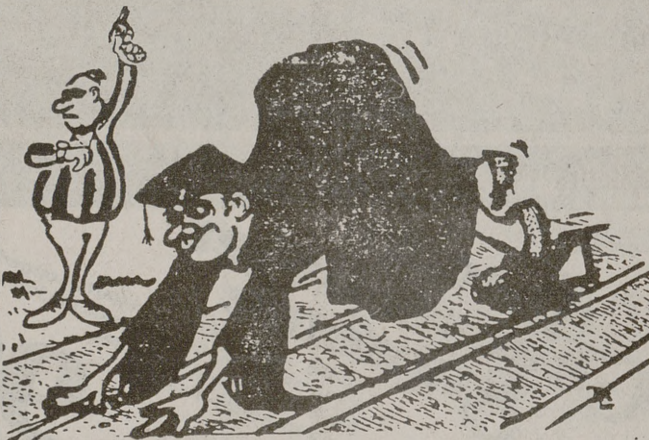
