Tax-exempt bonds wanted for project

United Press International HOUSTON — The future of the latest Texas offshore port project may depend on whether the state will allow tax exempt bonds to be issued for financing, the president of the firm backing the project says.

"We're just in a holding pat-tern right now," C.A. Brace, president of Texas Offshore Port Inc. and distribution manager for Phillips Petroleum Co., said Monday in a telephone intervie

"If the State of Texas determines they cannot help us get exempt financing, that would make the economics of the project worse than it is without tax-exempt financing," Brace said. Gov. William P. Cements Jr. has asked Attorrey General Mark White for an opinion on the possibility of axexempt bonds

Brace said TOP's Department of Transportation livense expires June 21 unless construction has begun. He said officials of Phillips, Dow Chemical Co., Conoco Inc. and Seaway Pipe-line Co. now must decide whether to seek an extension. With the recession, ande oil
