Martin Bander, a spokesman at Massachusetts General Hospital, said surgery began about 8 a.m. and lasted about five hours. Tuesday, doctors said Kissin-

ger's coronary artery disease was diagnosed following special xray tests called Angiograms.

Kissinger, 58, was reported in good physical condition, aside from his heart ailment, and doctors said they expect the fourhour bypass operation to be successful

"The chances of everything going well are very high," said Dr. Gerald Austen, a long-time family friend and physician, who was to help perform the surgery along with senior heart surgeon Dr. Mortimer Buckley.
