Park ranger protests firing

HOUSTON — Tim Passman, a state park ranger fired from his maintenance job on the Battleship Texas near the San Jacinto Monument, said he has been wrongfully accused of violating orders by telling reporters the

80-year-old ship's hull was leaking.
Capt. Andrew Garcia, executive director of the ship, fired Passman Monday. He said he had instructed employees that all information must come from him.

"He was fired mainly because he was not the type of employee we wanted," Garcia said.
Workers on the battleship noticed the leaks Friday, and water filled several lower compartments before pumps were brought in.

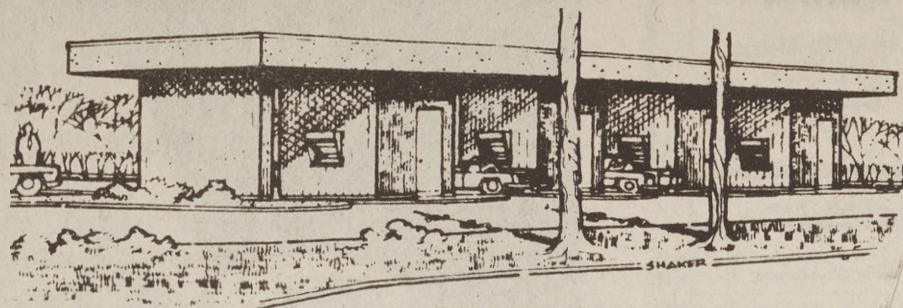

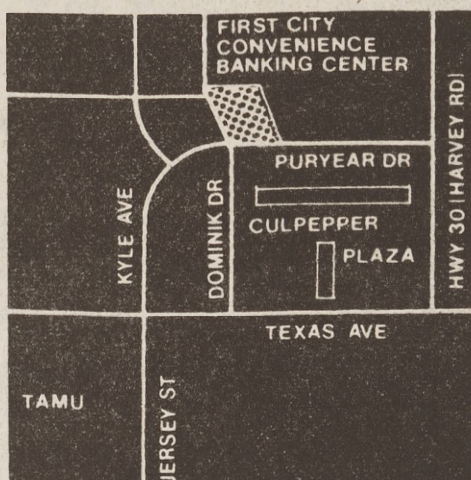
