Home computers to be used in Texas Tech laboratory

LUBBOCK — Texas Tech University will develop a Computer Learning Laboratory using 35 home computer systems donated by Texas Instruments Inc., a university spokesman says.

The computer system, which will be housed in the university's library, should be in full operation by spring, Academic Affairs Vice President John R. Darling said Wednesday.

Darling, who submitted the proposal to TI, said the computer laboratory would be used by students and faculty in the agriculture, mathematics, business administration, psychology education and engineering departments.

Rocket launch test in Army success

DALLAS — The Multiple Launch Rocket System, being developed for the U.S., French, German and British armies, carried a full load of 12 rockets during testing, officials report. LTV Corp., based in Dallas, built the 12 MLRS rockets which were launched in less than a minute at the White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico.

The 12 rockets hurled thousands of live submunitions — each similar to a grenade — onto a target area 9.6 miles away, LTV announced.

Armed with a standard XM-77 warhead — intended for use against enemy troops and material — the rockets destroyed or disabled trucks, guns and equipment set up in the target area.
