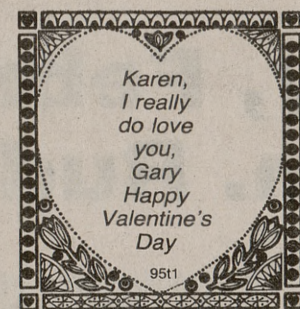

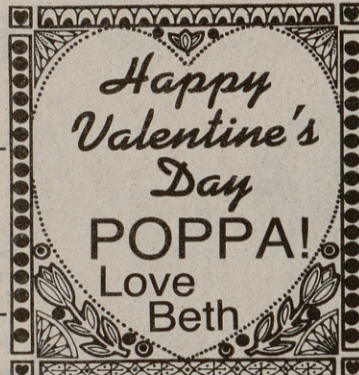

Forecaster sees sunspots when telling weather

This unusually cold winter is
going to stay that way for a while
and the next two winters won't
be any better according to a
weather forecaster who uses a
controversial long-range
method — the monitoring of
sunspots.

The same forecaster in Octo-
ber accurately predicted the cur-
rent below-normal cold wave.

Douglas Paine, an atmos-
pheric scientist at the New York
State College of Agriculture and
Life Sciences at Cornell Univer-
sity in Ithaca, N.Y., predicted an
exceptionally cold winter was in
store for much of the central
plains region and the Midwest
— predictions that were right on
target.

"So far," he said, "tempera-
tures over those areas have been
running significantly below
normal."

In the Northeast, Paine said,
temperatures have dropped one
or two degrees below normal on
average. He had predicted that
the region would face tempera-
tures 2 to 4 degrees below nor-
mal this winter.

During the remainder of the
winter, Paine said the Western
part of the United States will be
hit by another cold spell, with
Arctic air blasts expected to hit
the Rocky Mountain states.

On the bright side, he pre-
dicts above normal tempera-
tures will prevail in the south-
eastern states, particularly Flori-
da and Georgia.

But in the Northeast, he said,
will continue to experience be-
low normal temperatures.
Paine predicts a streak of un-
usually cold winters for the
Northeast through 1984.

Paine makes his somewhat
chilling predictions with the use
of new forecasting techniques
that take into account, among
other things, sunspot activity.
The technique is considered
controversial among other
atmospheric scientists.

"We take a 20-year average of
winter seasonal averages and
plot these out over a 40-year
period," he said. The technique
requires fixing the sunspot max-
imum and minimum regularly.

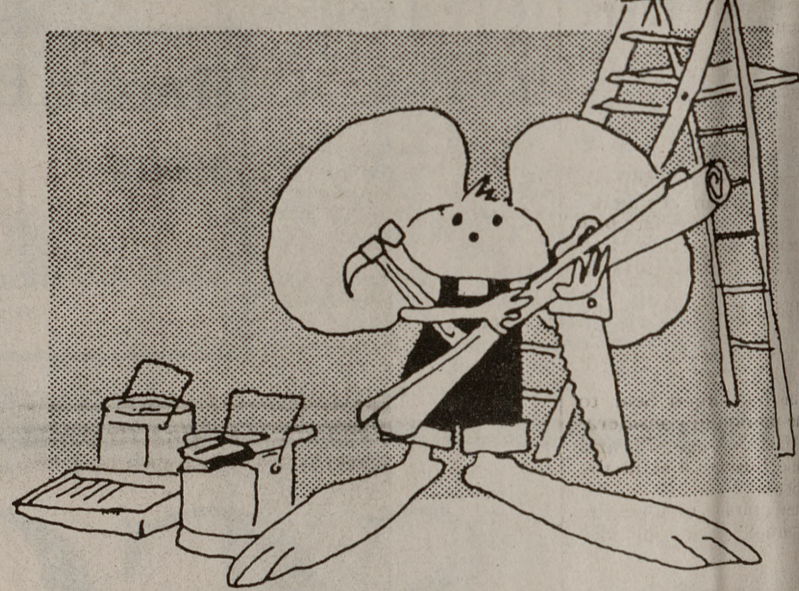
"There has been a cool-
ing trend since 1950 and we've
verified that the cooling trend
sunspots hit their maximum
1980 and are heading toward
minimum in 1986. We feel
variability (which triggers
release from the oceans) is an
important ingredient in mate
prediction.

"These 20-year aver-
age chart the acceleration in
cooling trend which takes
in early winter. In the
1960s, it was above normal
for four winters in succe-
ssion. We'll have below normal
features."

Paine says that during the
year running average, he
"found no one-to-one rela-
ship," meaning there can be
association with a large sun-
spot that translates into a hard
winter one year with any future
years.

Paine says the techniq-
ues "fact years in adv-
ance while most other fore-
casters struggle to forecast the
first of December and the rest
of the month."
