Automobile sales drop despite large rebates

DETROIT — Auto sales have plunged to their lowest level in more than two decades and another 6,000 autoworkers face indefinite layoffs, indicating even huge rebates aren't enough to entice Americans to buy new cars.
Local United Auto Workers union leaders met in Detroit Tuesday to review a proposed contract with Ford Motor Co. The contract, calling for union wage and benefit concessions in return for better job security, is expected to be endorsed by the union's Ford Council in Chicago today.
General Motors Corp. is expected to try to get the union to return to the bargaining table, but UAW President Douglas Fraser — apparently still smarting from failed negotiations earlier this year — said Monday he would tell GM "where to go."
Fraser was scheduled to address skilled trades workers in Detroit Tuesday as part of the meeting to look over the contract.

Inmates won't testify, charged with contempt

GALVESTON — A federal judge has forbidden Texas prison officials from intimidating inmates who want to testify on behalf of Eroy Brown, on trial in the drowning of his warden who one inmate described as violent and dangerous.
Defense Attorney Craig Washington contends Brown acted in self-defense in a struggle leading to the death of Warden Wallace Pack, 54, at the Texas Department of Corrections' Ellis Unit April 4, 1981.
Ellis Unit Farm Manager Billy Max Moore, 49, also died in the struggle but no trial date has been set yet in that case.
Prosecutors contend Brown killed the prison officials in a rage over a denied furlough.
Monday's court activity was highlighted by a contempt ruling from Judge Henry Dalehite, the order issued against TDC by

"We want this to be a day Lansing will remember," Michael "Renegade" Hammond said of the unusual marriage ceremony he has planned with fellow trucker Jerri Sue "Wild Honey" Pine.
"We thought we'd leave Lansing with one more remembrance," said Pine, 34, of Lansing, who will be moving with her new husband to Texas after the ceremony.
The wedding is set for 5:30 p.m. in the parking lot of Don's Windmill Truck Stop in suburban Dimondale.
As befits the general theme, the wedding party will shun formal dresses and morning coats in favor of flannel shirts, blue jeans and cowboy boots and hats.
Hammond, 28, of Nashville, Mich., has even rewritten the ceremony into CB lingo.
Anyone opposing the marriage will be asked to "break now or keep their transmitter Q.T." The two will acknowledge each other with "10-4" and "roger" and end with a vow to "love, honor and cherish — until death do take us on our last ride."
