Proxmire defends his 'Golden Fleece'

United Press International WASHINGTON — Senator Bill Proxmire (D-Wisconsin), has been made an honorary member of the Flat Earth Society and been called a hypocrite many times over. He even calls himself an SOB, of sorts.

But the senior senator has won enduring fame since for his Scrooge-like dedication to eliminating government waste and his invention of the "Golden Fleece Award," presented every month since March 1975 to the best example of ridiculous federal spending.

He is a charter member of an informal Senate group whose motto is "Save Our Bucks." They are known as "SOBs."

The first Golden Fleece went to an \$84,000 National Science Foundation grant to study why people fall in love. The most recent went to an Agriculture Department-funded study finding that fast-food addicts are patriotic and vegetarians are intellectual.

Other notable winners were a study on whether pregnant pigs would suffer less stress if they jogged on a treadmill, a variety of gold-plated Pentagon and public works projects and research into why monkeys clench their jaws.

Proxmire used the advance and royalties, plus television talk show fees, from his fifth and latest book, "The Fleecing of America," to repay the U.S. Treasury.

Proxmire bluntly enunciated his philosophy in the book: "No one has a God-given right to public funds. If people getting public money can't defend their use of it, they shouldn't get it." Proxmire is a publicity glut, which does not embarrass him in the least. "Most members of the Senate appreciate that one way you get your job done is getting public attention for calling attention to foolish things," he said.

It didn't start as the "Golden Fleece." Proxmire's staff first thought of a "Rip-Off of the Month," "Spending Crime of the Month," "Give-Away" and "Throw-Away."

"We finally settled on fleece as the proper word for a smooth, legalized theft from the taxpayers," Proxmire says in his book.

The press releases announcing the dubious award are provocative, sarcastic and full of puns. Sometimes the targets, usually social science research, seem unfairly chosen — unusual sounding topics that conceivably could advance human knowledge. The same sort of titles can

be found in any academic library or Ph.D. dissertations.

In his book, Proxmire was candid about the criticism and the shouts of "hypocrisy." After all, Proxmire does use the Senate gym to shower every day after jogging from home, and a recent 16-hour speech fighting the trillion-dollar debt ceiling cost the Senate \$64,000 to stay open all night just so he could talk.

After he gave a "Fleece" to the space agency for studying the possibility of extraterrestrial intelligence, the American Association for the Advancement of Science made him an honorary

member of the Flat Earth Society.

Proxmire concedes: "The country has benefited immensely from federally supported scientific research. Government agencies should not be bullied by United States senators or anyone else into feigning or tating to award funds to some competent scientists."

He says reporters always contact the recipient of a Golden Fleece award, and "If I'm wrong in my criticism, the public can decide after hearing both sides."

Adverse publicity is not likely to stop the 66-year-old maverick, who, after losing three times for the Wisconsin governorship, succeeded Joe McCarthy in the Senate in 1957. Among his claims to fame is the fact he was the first senator to get a heart transplant and a facelift.

He now says he will probably run for a fifth full term in 1982, although he is considering the far-off options, running for governor again and running president.

While the Golden Fleece made Proxmire a national figure, he has long been immensely popular at home, spending only \$177 to win election in 1976, protecting dairy farmers, opposing bus in Milwaukee and answering every roll call since 1966.

He is proud that two-thirds of the projects awarded the Golden Fleece were ended or shut out back after the publication

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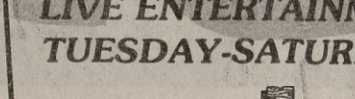
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
