South African commission calls for press limitations

United Press International JOHANNESBURG, South Africa (UPI) — A new government commission report on the mass media could spell the end to press freedom in South Africa.

The 1,400-page report calls for severe limitations on the ownership of newspapers and the people who work for them.

It specifies a 12-man press council, heavily weighted in favor of the government, which would have the right to impose press standards on the country by being able to reprimand journalists, fine them and suspend or bar them from their profession.

It recommended making it illegal for any individual to own more than 1 percent of a newspaper and restricting employment in the mass media to people licensed to work by the government.

Many of the commission's recommendations were cloaked in obscurities, but critics, including virtually everyone in the media and most of the liberal community, said its meaning was clear — a complete and permanent clampdown on the freedom of expression.

Prime Minister P.W. Botha responded by insisting the report only amounted to recommendations and that negotia-

tions would be held with the media before anything was passed into law.

Despite this assurance, most senior newspaper executives have remained skeptical about the government's intentions. Some viewed the report as a possible decoy to divert attention while a mass of other repressive press legislation is slipped through parliament. Others saw the offer of negotiations as a hammer to hold over the media's head indefinitely.

They argue that South Africa already has enough anti-press laws to defy the imagination of most attorneys. The maze of 90 different acts even restricts local

media from reporting on government corruption without government permission.

The most sweeping of these laws — the national security act — prevents newspapers from publishing anything about security matters without official approval. The government also has the right to prevent reporting on race riots by declaring areas affected "national points" and sealing them from reporters.

Recently even the free press has begun to feel the tightening noose of press repression.
