## Basketball does battle with X-rated movies

**HONEY GROVE** — One popular indoor sport could determine the fate of another in this small farming town where a dispute over X-rated films has taken a back seat to the high school girl's basketball team.

Jacob Larry Burris, owner of The Grove Theater, says he is rooting for the Warriorettes to win the state championship as a matter of civic pride.

Church of Christ minister Jimmy Dale Burgess also wants the team to succeed, but he sees it as a matter of civic salvation.

For several weeks, Burgess has been trying to shut down the town's only theater because Burris shows adult movies on Friday and Saturday nights.

Burgess, given little hope of a legal remedy by city officials, issued and then backed off from a threat to photograph customers exiting the theater last Friday night and release the photos to area newspapers.

Burris shows G-rated movies during the week and offers a free "kiddy show" on Saturday afternoons. Burris says he doesn't allow anyone under 18 to pay the \$5 admission and watch the adult movies.

Burris remained unyielding about his right to do business in this northeast Texas community as long as he violates no laws.

"It's more or less stalemated right now," said Joe T. Morrow, editor and publisher of the Honey Grove Signal Beacon.

But Burgess predicts the issue will be decided on the basketball courts.

"I'll tell you one thing for sure," Burgess said. "The girl's basketball team plays in the regionals Friday in Denton. If they win Friday, they play Saturday."

"If they win Saturday, they go to state the next weekend. I don't know if he (Burris) can survive two weekends of this being a ghost town."

Burris said: "I'm for the bas-

ketball team and I hope the real well, but we'll be here for force.

"The basketball game hurt a little, but they won us under. Like I said, a large percentage of the Honey Grove support the theater and we have a lot of letters from out of town."

Burris declined comment on advice from attorney.

If the theater survives potential two weekends of town basketball, he said, he will continue to halt screening of the films, Burgess, who claims part of other congregations this town of 1,900, said no division will remain the primary in his crusade.

As for attempts to persuade Burris, Burgess said, he offered to help him in some other occupation.

Burris said: "Everybody a livelihood, this is mine

## Health officials upset by leprosy outbreak

**EL PASO** — Health officials on both sides of the border are concerned about a significant outbreak of Hansen's Disease, better known as leprosy, in Juarez, Mexico.

Dr. Philip L. Zbylot, a resident physician for the Texas Department of Public Health, said most of Texas' 408 active Hansen's Disease cases were diagnosed in "hotspots" along the southern border with Mexico.

"Otherwise, Texas doesn't really have much of a problem

with Hansen's," he said Wednesday. "The fear is that we're getting a spillover from Mexico."

About 50 health officials from the United States and Mexico were scheduled to meet Thursday in Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, for a Hansen's disease workshop sponsored by the U.S.-Mexico Health Council.

The increase in the number of reported cases in Juarez will be among items on the workshop agenda.

Juarez physician Luis A.N. Gomez said he diagnosed 40

new cases of Hansen's disease in the Juarez area last year.

Some officials questioned the figure, but the Texas Department of Health described

number of new cases as significant compared with 80 cases reported for March 1980.

Zbylot's statistics show a decrease in Hansen's Disease in Texas. He said 35 new cases were reported last year — the same number reported the year since 1975.
