**OFFICIAL NOTICE**  
PORT ARTHUR — Two officers of the Delta Norte, a barge carrier out of New Orleans, have been charged with negligence in the ship's collision with a Liberian freighter in the Gulf of Mexico.  
Coast Guard investigator Lt. Jack Hardin also recommended similar charges be applied against the crewmen of the freighter, the African Pioneer, and said he would recommend his findings be passed to the governments of Liberia and Yugoslavia. The Pioneer's crew were mostly Yugoslavs.  
The charges against master Jessie W. Gunn and second officer Daniel P. Lynch of the Delta Norte are scheduled for trial March 25 in a Port Arthur federal court before Administrative Law Judge Thomas E.P. McElligott of Houston.  
The charges, Hardin said, do not assess blame for the Feb. 19 collision which resulted in two serious injuries and almost caused the 511-foot Pioneer to sink.  
Hardin completed a four-day formal hearing into the collision Monday, then served Gunn with two counts of negligence and Lynch with one, alleging the Delta Norte was traveling too fast in foggy conditions.  
Hardin also recommended charges against the Pioneer for going too fast. Both were at full throttle seconds before the bow of the 809-foot Delta Norte tore into the Pioneer's left side.  
The Delta Norte is owned by Delta Steamship Lines of New Orleans.  
Hardin said he would decide on the cause of the collision and release his findings in 90 days.

## Political races hot under Texas sun

Sen. Lloyd Bentsen has been labeled a "fair-weather friend of the taxpayers" by one Republican challenger who criticized Bentsen's joining with other Democrats seeking to defer a federal income tax cut.  
The challenger, Sen. Walter Mengden, R-Houston, Tuesday also challenged Rep. Jim Collins, his opponent for the GOP nomination to the seat now held by Bentsen, to actively oppose any postponement of federal tax cuts.  
"Bentsen is showing his true colors," Mengden said. "He voted for the tax cuts when they were popular in Congress. Now he is seeking to quietly discard them."  
"I urge Collins to speak up on this issue. Here's an excellent opportunity to see whether he genuinely supports the principles of less government and less taxes."  
In other political activity Tuesday, Democratic Rep. Jim Mattox, restated his intent to seek the state attorney general's office despite speculation he might decide to seek re-election to Congress after a federal court restored his strongly Democratic congressional district in Dallas.  
In another race affected by the redrawing of district lines, Sen. Dee Travis, R-Garland, announced he plans to seek the Republican nomination for Congress from the 3rd District. Travis lived in the 5th District, but under the new redistricting plan, Travis' residence was shifted to the 3rd District.  
Railroad Commissioner Buddy Temple, a candidate for the Democratic nomination for governor, abruptly canceled his week's schedule of campaign activities Tuesday because of a mild case of pneumonia.  
An unsuccessful candidate for the Railroad Commission two years ago, Jim Hightower, claimed a poll shows he has overtaken incumbent Reagan V. Brown in the race for the Democratic nomination for Texas agriculture commissioner.  
Hightower, has moved ahead of Brown 34 percent to 30 percent in a survey taken by Opinion Analysts Inc. of 803 voters throughout the state who say they plan to vote in the May Democratic primary.

## Van company claims movers seek security

ST. LOUIS — Americans are flocking to oil-rich states in search of jobs and security.  
Robert J. Baer, executive vice president of United Van Lines, said a study of the firm's moving records indicated the greatest population movement was to warmer states and states prominent in the petroleum industry.  
"With energy independence becoming a major concern for our country, much of the movement seems to be to states that are rich in oil and natural gas, such as Texas, Oklahoma and Alaska," he said Tuesday.  
A study of 135,000 household moves that moved in 1981, showed the Washington, D.C., area recorded the largest gain. Oklahoma, where oil rigs dot the flat lands, was one of 13 states to gain in population.
