## Hometown meeting draws reporter back

*Editor's note: UPI reporter Kevin Goddard attended the annual town meeting in his hometown of Brookfield, Vt., Tuesday and filed this report.*

Meeting — which usually lasts well into the afternoon — might be over before lunch time.

The town budget has been passed without so much as a word of opposition. In fact, we are down to item 12 on a 13-item agenda and nobody had opposed anything.

Thank God for the arms freeze resolution. If things don't slow down, whole trays of lasagne will go to waste.

But lunch is saved. An elderly man up front has the crowd's

he said. "And I'm agin' it."

Brookfield, population about 1,000, has miles of gently rolling fields and forests, a sprinkling of still-operating dairy farms, elementary school, a farm equipment dealer, a country and ski-touring center.

And, it has a floating bridge — several hundred feet of wood that sits atop scenic Sunset Pond and puts Brookfield on the map.

Thousands of people take picture each year. It's very "Vermonty," as we sometimes say.

But the floating bridge, summer thing, and winter is very much with us this Town Meeting Day as 100 people at the elementary school hall talk of death and destruction and the possibility of nuclear holocaust.

"Most of us have never known what it is to be bombed everything I learn frightens more," says a middle-aged woman. "I really feel that we're talking about mankind's survival, and that time is running out."

The resolution is similar one that was discussed in March 1979 at the Vermont town meeting on Tuesday, most of which dored it.

When a voice vote is finally taken, it is inconclusive. A tally is done by standing. First the ayes get to their feet then the nays.

Brookfield votes 62-41 in favor of a resolution urging nuclear arms freeze. I'm surprised — not by the vote, because the young knitter woman in her early 20s, stepped up and was counted among nays.
