## Peyote lack may threaten Indian rituals

MIRANDO CITY — Indians have partaken of hallucinogenic peyote as a religious sacrament for centuries, but a severe shortage of the cactus buttons is threatening to end the rituals for members of the exclusive Native American Church.

David Cardenas is the only federally licensed peyote dealer remaining in this South Texas city, located about 30 miles east of Laredo. For more than a century the town has been the prime peyote shopping center for thousands of Indian church members across the nation.

But Cardenas, 65, says his days as a peyote seller are numbered, because local ranchers, wary of thefts on their land, have refused to let him harvest the cactus buttons, which are trimmed to bite-size and dried in the sun before being consumed.

"Right now, the peyote is becoming so very scarce," Cardenas said. "The ranchers won't allow anybody to go over there and harvest the peyote, and that's the only reason it is so hard to find it now."

"These ranchers that we have here think we can go over there and steal a calf or kill some deer. They're really jealous about their land. They have a big lock on every gate. You can't break the lock to get in or you're trespassing and you're likely to get killed."

"I like to help the Indian people," Cardenas continued. "They're the nicest people in the world. And this is the only place that you can find peyote of the Rio Grande."

The 300,000 members of Christianity-based Native American Church — who are the only people in the United States permitted to consume peyote, an illegal drug, have used the buttons since the 1800s.

Hundreds of church members converge on Mirando City for a kind of religious convention every February. This year's meeting, however, was marred by a lack of the sacramental cactus buttons, which are used in ceremonies much like traditional Christian churches use bread and wine.

"The peyote belongs to the Indians," Cardenas, a Mexican American, said. "It's a medicine for the Indians and the government will not take it away from them because that is their belief. Just like I'm 100 percent Catholic, they believe in it."

The price of peyote, when available, has skyrocketed.

"Twenty years ago, it was out \$2.50 or \$3 a thousand (pounds)," Cardenas, who estimates he has made as much as \$60,000 a year selling peyote, said.

"The Indians pay too much for the peyote now," he said. "When you can get it, it's at \$50 or \$60 a thousand."

Cardenas said in addition his problems with uncooperative ranchers, the federal government is getting more strict about its peyote licensing procedures.
