Hagler-Hearns fight to be held May 24

United Press International NEW YORK (UPI) — For the winner, it will be another multimillion dollar payday against either Sugar Ray Leonard or Wilfred Benitez. For the loser, it's uncertainty and having to prove himself again.

Those will be the stakes when world middleweight champion Marvin Hagler defends his title against former World Boxing Association welterweight champion Thomas Hearns May 24, most likely in Reno, Nev. The winner will be in excellent position to face either Benitez, the World Boxing Council junior middleweight champion who is looking for a fourth title, or Leonard, who is seeking a third title and who won the undis-puted welterweight crown by stopping Hearns in 14 rounds last September.

'Whoever wins this fight will be the key target for Benitez and Leonard," said Emanuel Steward, Hearns' trainer-manager who would love to get a rematch with Leonard.
