UT heart team to do organ study

HOUSTON — Physicians at the University of Texas Medical School want to re-establish heart transplants by working with Dr. Denton Cooley and his surgical team at the Texas Heart Institute.

Dr. Barry Kahan, director of UT's organ transplant program, said Wednesday that plans have been completed to start a transplant team. But Dr. Ernst Knobil, the university's new dean, said the plans are tentative.

Knobil said the program fate hinges on the availability of a drug called cyclosporin A used in kidney transplants.

He said the Food and Drug Administration is considering the approval of the drug in Houston transplants, as it has for the Stanford University Medical Center in California.

Out of the 214 heart transplants performed at Stanford since 1968, 80 were successful. Twenty-six of those operations were done using cyclosporin A, and Kahan said the results are encouraging.

The drug destroys white blood cells which cause the body to reject a transplanted organ without destroying the other white blood cells that protect against infection.

Kahan said the drug also proved to be successful in the kidney transplants. Most of the kidneys implanted are still functioning after a year, he said.

Cooley implanted an artificial heart in a Dutchman last July who later received a human transplant. But the man died soon after the transplant.

Between 1968 and 1980, Cooley performed 21 heart transplants. Only one of his patients lived longer than a few months, and that one died after 16 months.

Dr. Michael DeBakey of Baylor College of Medicine performed 12 heart transplants at Methodist Hospital between 1968 and 1970. Although those patients are now deceased, the longest survivor lived 5 years.

Elderly man offers land to jobless

MANVEL — An elderly man who lives in a railroad car said he is willing to share his one-acre plot of land with a few of the homeless job seekers who have been flocking to Texas recently in hopes of finding a new life.

Lucian Smith, 63, who runs a magazine subscription service from his home and railroad car, said Wednesday that recent news stories depicting the plight of desperate families who felt they had to leave their children to welfare agencies prompted him to make his offer.

His only stipulation is that non-paying tenants be in serious pursuit of employment for a job that will get them on their feet and eventually off his land.

"I've been reading recently about people coming to Houston who are forced to stay in campgrounds and have to move every week or so, people who are actually looking for someone to take their children because they can't afford to care for them," Smith said.
