



Wednesday night to what only a few weeks ago seemed to be a most unlikely spot in the NBA

The Dallas Mavericks, meanwhile, gave their home fans a brief glimpse at what the future probably holds.

Denver, as it turned out, won yet another thriller Wednesday evening, 120-119, and extended its winning streak to 11 games. That is a club record for the Nuggets since they entered the NBA and puts them only two games back of the San Antonio Spurs in the battle for the Midwest Division crown.

Not so long ago the Nuggets were wallowing around the .500 mark at 31-30. But now they are not only in excellent shape to seize a playoff spot, they have a chance to either host a firstround mini-series or even avoid having to play in the first round


