HOUSTON — An undersecretary says there is no way to determine how much taxpayers will save when the Department of Energy is abolished, because many of its services and procedures will be turned over to other cabinet-level departments.
"Over a period of time, it will save money," Undersecretary Guy Fiske said. "But we will get away from having advocates from within the department. The silly things and the things that don't belong in the government will be gone."
However, Fiske said it may take another session of Congress before the Energy Department is dismantled as promised by the Reagan administration.
He said dissolving the department has met with some delays because of the Congressional election this year.
"It will not get the early attention as we thought," he said. "It must go first through the Senate and then through the House."
Fiske was in Houston to speak to the Texas Industrial Commission, an agency which helps attract new businesses to the state and provides assistance to established companies.
He said a federal agency should not be regulating the energy industry, "because the free market should be the one that regulates and not the government."
Fiske quickly pointed with pride to an example of what happens when the government gets out of regulating businesses. He said since gasoline was decontrolled by President Reagan, the market now dictates the price.
Although the price of gasoline quickly climbed until it reached about \$1.50 a gallon, it is now down to its lowest level since mid-1979.

Frontierswomen viewed wrongly, researcher says

Contrary to popular opinion, women who travelled the Iowa frontier trail did not cry and beg to go home, a university researcher says.
Glenda Riley, a history professor at the University of Northern Iowa in Cedar Falls, said most accounts of the frontier trail were written by male historians, who inaccurately stereotyped the frontier women.
"I divided the stereotypes into two categories," she said. "First was the 'saint in the sunbonnet.' This was the sturdy, hardy woman who tromped along behind the wagon, nursing a baby with one arm and shooting Indians with the other."
"The second was the 'madonna of the prairie'; the pale, eastern woman who had fallen in love with a man with wanderlust in his eye. She's the one who never made it. She was always crying and either died or was killed on the trail."
Riley said these women are really caricatures. "There must have been some saints and there must have been some madonnas, but they can't speak to the average woman on the frontier trail," she said.
As she set out to discredit such reports, Riley read frontier women's diaries and letters never touched by previous historians.
Her research is documented in the book "Frontierswomen: The Iowa Experience," which says some women cried and moaned over the hardships. But many others did wonderfully.
"Even when things were terrible and they were crying, they said things like: 'There's nothing I can do but I wisheth myself had East to live.'"
Riley said some women hated the stress and adversity, but the majority said it
