In Britain, where the DPT shot is no longer mandatory, a compensation program has been set up to provide financial assistance to children disabled misinformed about the vaccine's risks and most adverse reactions to it are not reported.

Reporter Lea Thompson who authored the report said, based on the numbers of British children eligible for compensation, there are probably 272 Amer-ican children left severely disabled and retarded by the vac-




