After investigating potential employers, students attend a counseling session with a director and decide where they would like to work.

A cover recommendation letter and a copy of the co-op degree plan are sent to the employer with the student's application. The employer is asked to make a decision in three to four weeks. The offer or rejection letter is sent directly to the student.

Students who participate in the co-op program must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5. Students also may receive academic credit, if his college offers credit for co-oping. The colleges of liberal arts and geos-ciences do not offer academic credit for co-oping.
