

Birthdays shutout

Wilcox lifts Tigers, 8-0

Milt Wilcox allowed only one hit — a one-out single by Jerry Martin past fallen shortstop Alan Trammell with one out in the second inning — Tuesday night in pitching Detroit to an 8-0 victory over Kansas City on his 32nd birthday.

Wilcox, 1-1, making his second start and first since April 12, struck out nine and walked

five. He retired 12 straight batters at one point from the third through the seventh innings. Martin's grounder was hit to the left of second base as Trammell fell down trying to field it. The ball was several feet beyond him and it was questionable whether he could have come up with it.

"Trammell told me he couldn't have gotten the ball

even if he hadn't slipped," Detroit Manager Sparky Anderson said.

Rookie Glenn Wilson triggered a six-run second inning with a two-run double to pace the Tigers to their fourth straight triumph.

In other AL games, Boston toppled Baltimore, 8-3, Cleveland downed Texas, 9-4, New York throttled Chicago, 11-2,

Seattle beat California, 6-4, and Oakland edged Minnesota, 4-3, in 16 innings. Toronto at Milwaukee was postponed because of cold weather.

At Boston, Glenn Hoffman hit his second homer in three days, a two-run shot in the fourth inning that capped a three-run rally and enabled the Red Sox to hand Baltimore its seventh straight loss.

Coogs, Frogs pick up victories

Solid pitching performances from Doug Drabek and Rob Riley plus a balanced hitting attack led the Houston Cougars to a doubleheader sweep Tuesday over Stephen F. Austin, 7-1 and 10-1.

Drabek, a sophomore from Victoria, improved his record to

7-3 by limiting SFA to only three hits in four innings Tuesday. He walked two and struck out six before being replaced in the fifth by Mark Hall.

In the second game, the Cougars scored 10 runs by seven different players and Riley, 6-0, pitched four innings of no-hit

baseball before rightfielder Brett Babb singled in the fifth. Riley allowed only one more hit before yielding to Broc Higgins in the sixth.

Meanwhile, Senior Chris Leiss hurled a five-hit shutout to give Texas Christian University a 9-0 win over Southwest Texas

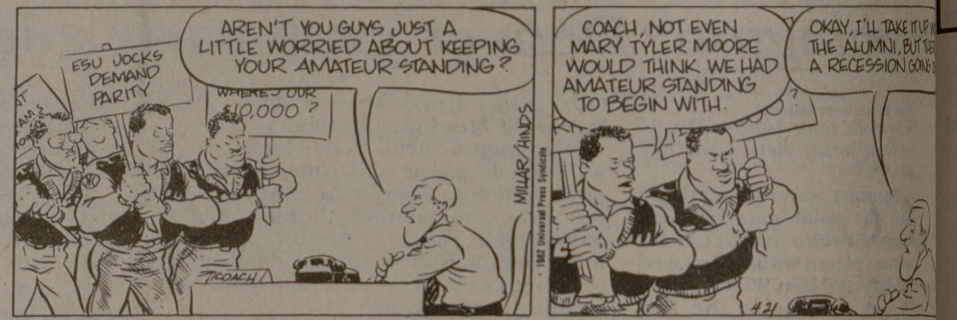
State and a split of their non-conference double-header.

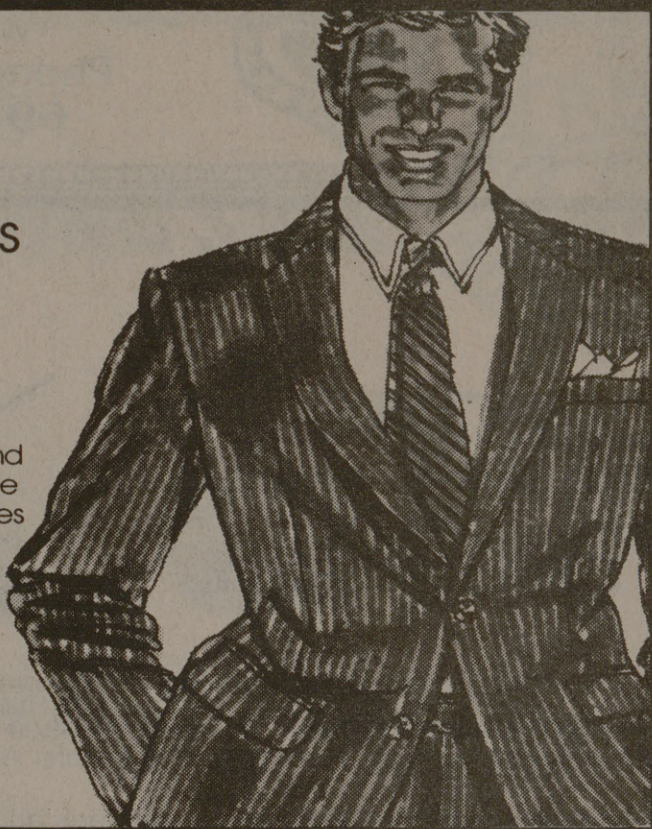

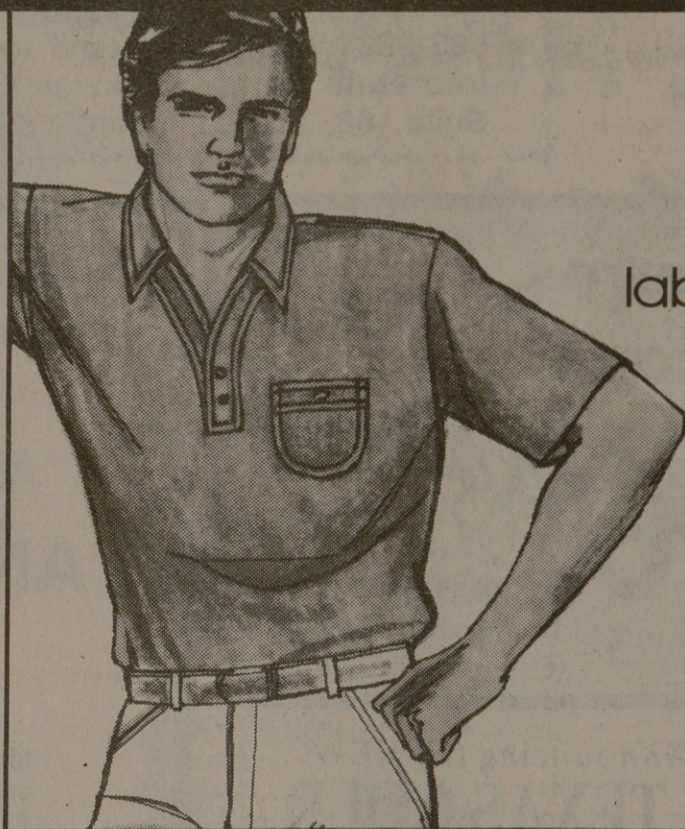

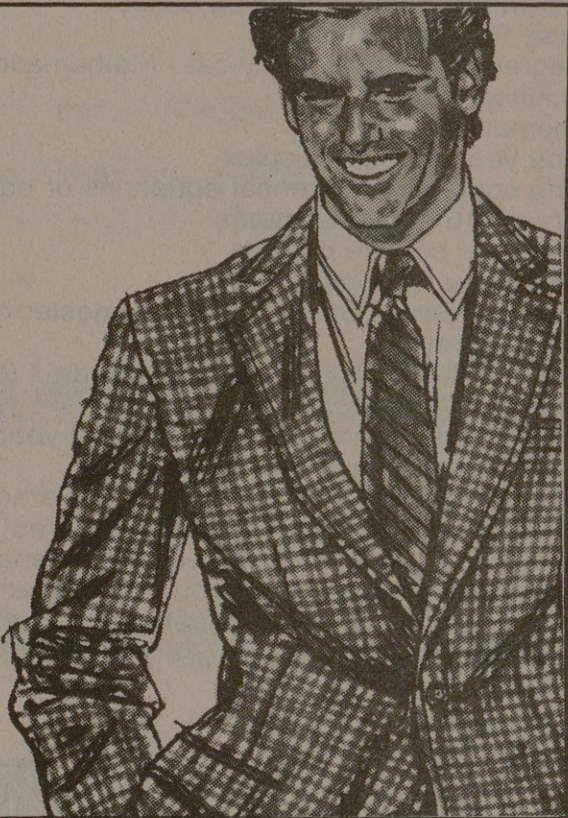
