"This is our chance to show what we've learned," Susan Dittman, president of the Dance Arts Society, said, "and to give the members a chance to perform."

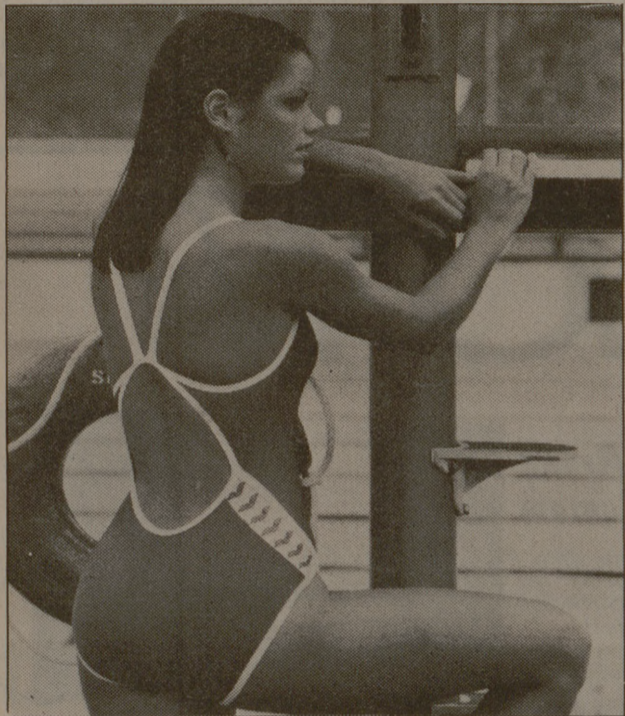
A University-recognized organization, the Dance Arts Society is open to anyone. Fees

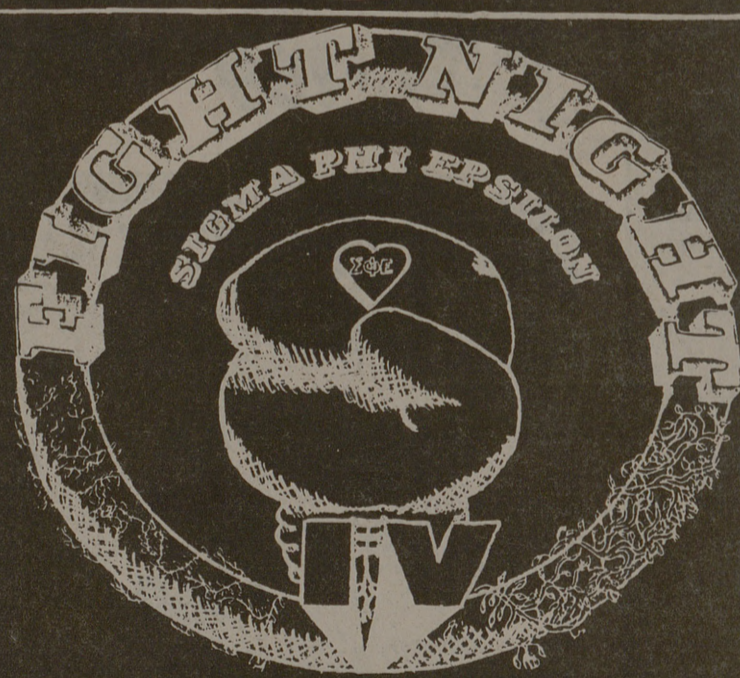
