State must reinstate welfare dental care

United Press International AUSTIN — A federal judge says the state has to reinstate a dental care program for welfare children that was severely curtailed in 1977.

The Legal Aid Society of Central Texas received the favorable verdict Tuesday in its suit against the Texas Department of Human Resources. The society sued the department on behalf of all welfare children.

Seeing U.S. the hard way — via surfboard. United Press International CORPUS CHRISTI — Frenchman Michel Maury, 19, wants to see America from atop a 2-foot-wide wind-propelled surfboard that he hopes will take him on a voyage circling the United States and touching its coastal towns.

"I like to sail and I like the idea of being out in the ocean and doing something different," Maury said. "It's never been done before."

Maury, from Chamonix, France, will try to sail 5,000 miles aboard a 12-foot-long surfboard — with an attached sail and rudder — that weighs 45 pounds and is less than an inch thick. "It looks exactly like a surfboard," Maury said. "You stand up on it and sail it like a boat, but you have to ... hold the boom all the time."

"He's ordered us to reinstate everything, but we're going to appeal it," Assistant Attorney General Ann Snell said.

Snell said that because the program is partially funded by the state, the federal courts have no jurisdiction. The federal government pays 55 percent of the program, which is meant to re-

duce future Medicaid expenses. Bunton rejected a plan by the state to reinstate only annual checkups, fluoride treatments and root canal work.

The program is expected to cost the state \$2.4 million in 1983 and possibly more if the department agrees to a 15 percent increase for dentists' fees.

The Department of Human Resources would like to resume the service in September, but the Legal Aid Society is pushing for an earlier deadline.
