A&M system. Another split the current universities and systems into seven systems.

Still another combined schools into five systems based on the existing systems. This proposal would have placed Texas Tech in the Texas A&M System.

The sheer size of Texas, however, required some form of state-wide coordination, Hubert said.

"We've got just about every kind of institution, and I think some coordination is obviously needed," he said.

"There's another proposal — I don't know whether this committee discussed it or not — which I think has some merit. That would be to have only two systems in the state — the University of Texas and Texas

A&M University systems."

Lawrence said he was satisfied with the plan as it is now.

"My hope is that it will make a more orderly organization and therefore impact favorably on the future of higher education," he said.

"I hope that we'll be able to be more efficient in educating the brilliant scholar to his maximum capability and at the same time take those of us who are not that brilliant and give us an education commensurate with every bit of the ability that we have.

"We feel that Texas higher education stands well by comparison in the nation — stands well by any comparison — but can certainly be improved, and that's what we've tried to do. There's nothing in there that I know of that is just patently impractical on its face."

The report also states regents serving now on university or system board would serve until their terms expired. After that time, the report recommends the establishment of guidelines to prohibit two regents from the same state senatorial district from serving on the same board.

Opposition was expressed to the plan by some task force members. Kaster said one task force member, Bernard Johnson, did not mind grouping universities into systems, but objected to the geographic basis for reorganization.

Another member, Aurora Sterling Bolin, said in a report that she felt the current structure allows more local partici-

ation in universities' affairs. She said she felt regional boards would create more bureaucracy and each institution would not receive the individual attention it now receives from its board.

Hubert said debate also may arise over the location of a system headquarters.

"I suspect there will be quite a bit of discussion along these lines at the legislative bodies," Hubert said.

Kaster said the task force's re-

commendations will be submitted to the governor May 6.
