# Library extends its hours through dead week, finals

The end of the semester means two things to most college students - final examinations and moving home.

In students' preparation for Texas A&M's exams next week, the Sterling C. Evans Library will extend its hours through dead week and finals week.

These additional hours will be available for study purposes only and library services will not

be provided after midnight or after 6 p.m. on Saturdays.

The library will be open from 7:30 a.m. to 2 a.m., today through Friday. On Saturday, the library will open at 9 a.m. and remain open continuously through 1 a.m., May 13.

On May 14, the last day of finals, the library will open at 7:30 a.m. and will close at 5 p.m.

Library hours will be from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on weekends and from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekdays, during the two-week break between the end of the spring semester and the first summer session.

Once the summer session begins, the library will be open from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekends and from 7:30 a.m. to 11 p.m. during the week.

Campus dormitories will also extend their hours for finals.

Quiet hours will go into effect 24 hours a day on Monday.

For many students, as soon as the trials of final exams end, the tribulations of dorm room check-outs begin.

Dormitory residents must be moved out of their dorm rooms by 6 p.m., May 14. Jim Wallace, supervisor for housing services and programs, said.

"Residents need to arrange a time to have their RA (resident advisor) check their room to make sure that it is clean, cleared

out, and that everything that should be," Wallace said.

Residents may lose all of their \$100 deposits if rooms are damaged in Wallace said.

Dr. Milton Weller, a distinguished wildlife scientist and head of the Entomology, Fisheries and Wildlife Department at the University of Minnesota, has been named to assume the Caesar Kleberg Chair in Wildlife Ecology at Texas A&M University.

The Kleberg Chair was made possible by a grant of more than \$600,000 from the Caesar Kleberg Foundation for Wildlife Conservation and additional financial support which will be provided by the Texas Agricul-

tural Experiment Station. Weller will accept his chair on August 1, 1977. One of his first projects will be to study the effects of agricultural practices on wildlife. Weller is currently a professor of wildlife ecology at the University of Minnesota. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota in 1960.

## Braniff, American renew fare battles
