Smoking a lingering risk for pill users

NEW YORK — The higher risk of heart attack among women who smoke and take birth control pills lingers in 40 to 49-year-olds if they continue to smoke after giving up the pill, researchers say.

"We estimate there are approximately 2,500 excess deaths from myocardial infarction in the United States each year among women in this age group (40-49) who smoke and are current or former users of oral contraceptives," federal health investigators said in a report Monday.

There is no evidence of a residual risk of heart attack among women who had used the pill when they were under 30, then stopped, said the report in "Family Planning Perspectives," the journal of the Alan Guttmacher Institute.

At its peak usage in the United States, the pill was used by about 10 million women. As reports of side effects have increased, however, use has slumped to below 7 million.

The report examined patterns among women 40 to 49 in a large case-control study of oral contraceptives under way at the Center for Disease Control in Atlanta.

It was based on an analysis by federal epidemiologists of a widely publicized study by the Drug Epidemiology Unit at Boston University — the first research unit to report an increased risk of heart attack among users of the pill. The risk was linked to an increase in age and duration of past pill use.

A related report in the journal cites three new British birth-control pill studies.

One shows little, if any, overall increase in the risk of cancerous tumors from birth-control pill use. A second finds a slightly increased risk of gall bladder

disease only in the first year of use.

A third attempts to assess the association between heart attacks and the estrogen content of the pill.

"It shows a twofold increase in the risk of heart attack among current pill users, but finds no difference in risk" between women taking pills with a higher and lower estrogen dosage, the British report said.

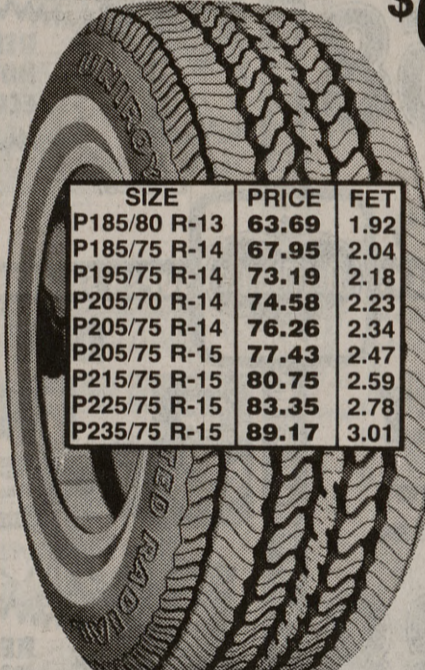

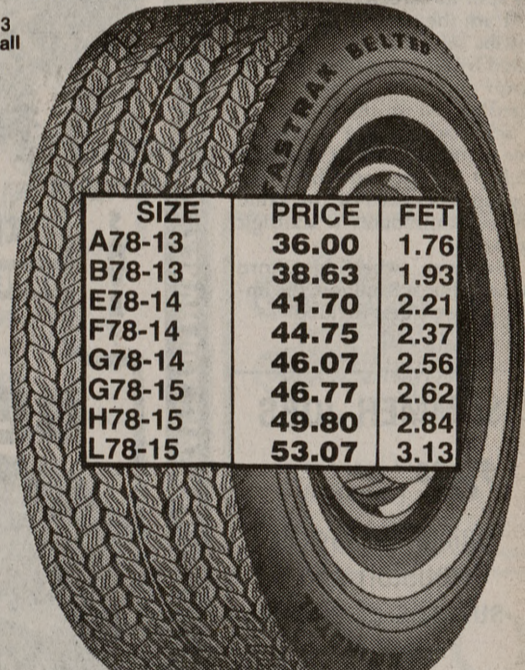

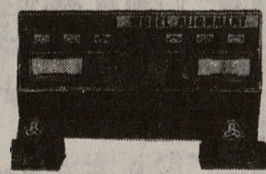

Man urges theft, gets life

MCKINNEY — A Dallas man, determined by a jury to have encouraged his three stepsons to steal, has been sentenced to life in prison.

Under the state's habitual criminal act, State District Judge Sue Holland sentenced Adolph Reyes Salmeron, 54, to life in prison for assisting and encouraging his teenaged stepsons to steal.

The Collin County jury Thursday decided Salmeron had misguided the youths in directing them to steal \$340 worth of stereo cassette players and headphones from a Plano department store. Salmeron was in

the store's snack bar at the time of the theft.

"The law says you are criminally responsible if you aid, direct or solicit other people to do your dirty work," Assistant District

Attorney Curt Henderson said Monday.

Henderson said Salmeron had been convicted in the last 20 years of more than 10 felony offenses.
