Reagan expected today to announce support for prayer in school

WASHINGTON — The 100plus guests President Reagan invited to a Rose Garden ceremony today are expecting him to fulfill a campaign promise and call for a constitutional amendment to put prayer back in public schools.

Evangelist Jerry Falwell, head of the Moral Majority, said Tuesday it was his understanding Reagan is going to propose a constitutional amendment to authorize voluntary group prayer in public schools.

According to published reports, White House staff members are drafting an amendment another of his promises by for the president to introduce. 


