juries occur at home, and nine out of 10 can be prevented, says the executive director of the Na-tional Society to Prevent Blindness.

An estimated 45 percent of all eye injuries are from home accidents, Virginia S. Boyce said. Industry requires protec-tive eyewear, but too many peo-ple do not use the same precautions in eye-threatening activities at home, she said.

The top causes of eye injuries at home involve home construction materials and hand and power tools, Boyce said.

Power mowers often throw rocks, sticks and other ground debris toward the face with great velocity, she said. To prevent accidents, the

society recommends wearing industrial quality safety glass while mowing the lawn or working
