Voting rules hinder blacks

ST. LOUIS — Federal laws against discrimination have not prevented voter registration procedures that are a major obstacle for hundreds of thousands of Southern blacks who want to vote, a newspaper and

that strike voters from election rolls unless they re-register.

- Double-registration laws that require some voters to register once or city elections and again for state and other elections.

- Requirements to show Social Security cards or be vouched for by other qualified voters.

- Limited hours and places to register.

- Refusal to conduct neighborhood registration drives.

- Few blacks appointed as deputy voting registrars.

- Refusal to use a "postcard registration" system.

- Little effort to publicize deadlines and locations for registration.

- Purges of voter lists that apparently remove more blacks than whites.

The St. Louis Post-Dispatch, the second part of a copyright violation in the field at a deep South, Monday said registration rules helped keep 2.5 million eligible blacks in seven southern states from voting in the 1980 presidential election. The newspaper conducted a three-month study of voting problems.

The Post-Dispatch said the obstacles blacks find to registration include:

Three employees killed during restaurant robbery

MOUNT PLEASANT — Three employees found dead Tuesday in a northeast Texas pizza restaurant were killed during an apparent robbery, police said.

The bodies were found about 2:30 a.m. Tuesday in the Pizza Hut restaurant in Mount Pleasant, about 100 miles east of Dallas.

A Department of Public Safety spokeswoman said four male

suspects were being sought in the murders. The victims had been shot, stabbed and apparently beaten with a hammer around midnight.

"They suspect a .38-caliber weapon, a butcher knife and a claw hammer were used," the DPS spokeswoman said.

Robbery was given as the apparent motive in the deaths.

Titus County District Attorney Charles M. Cobb said the bodies of two men and one

woman were taken to the Dallas County autopsy.




